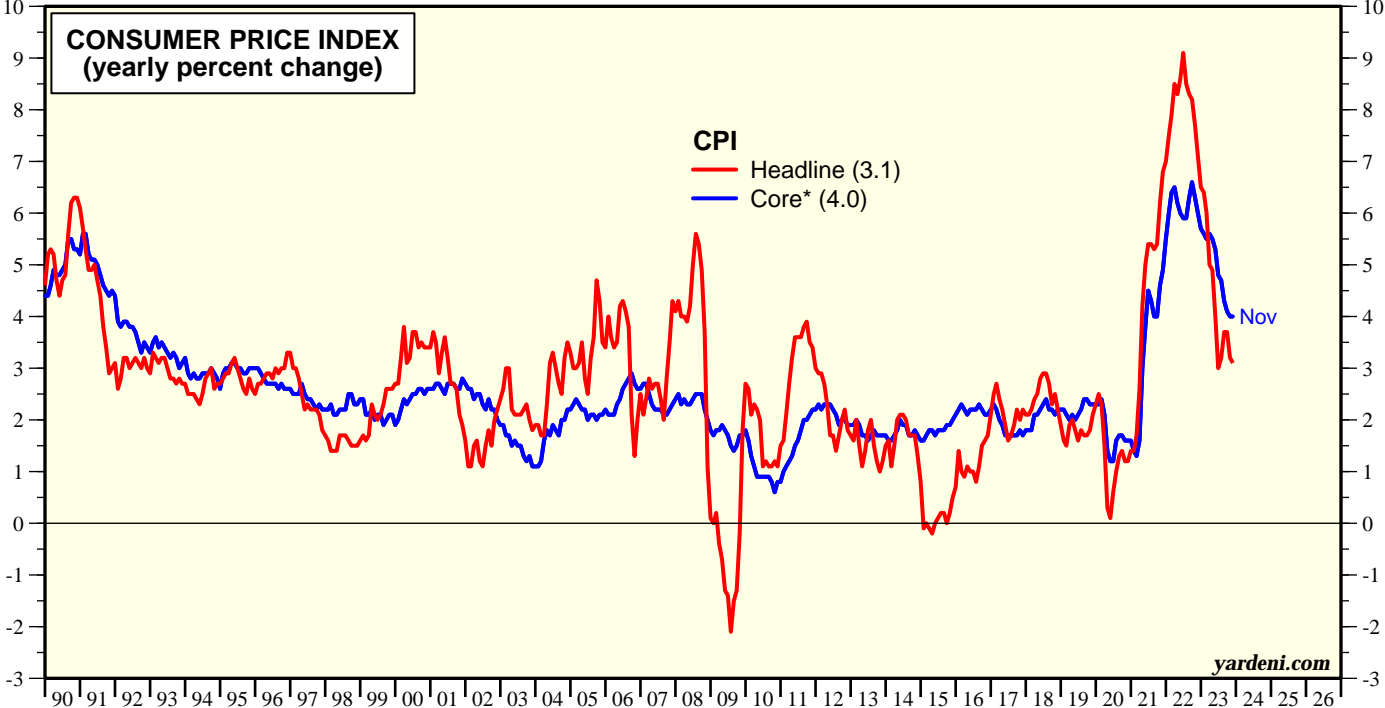

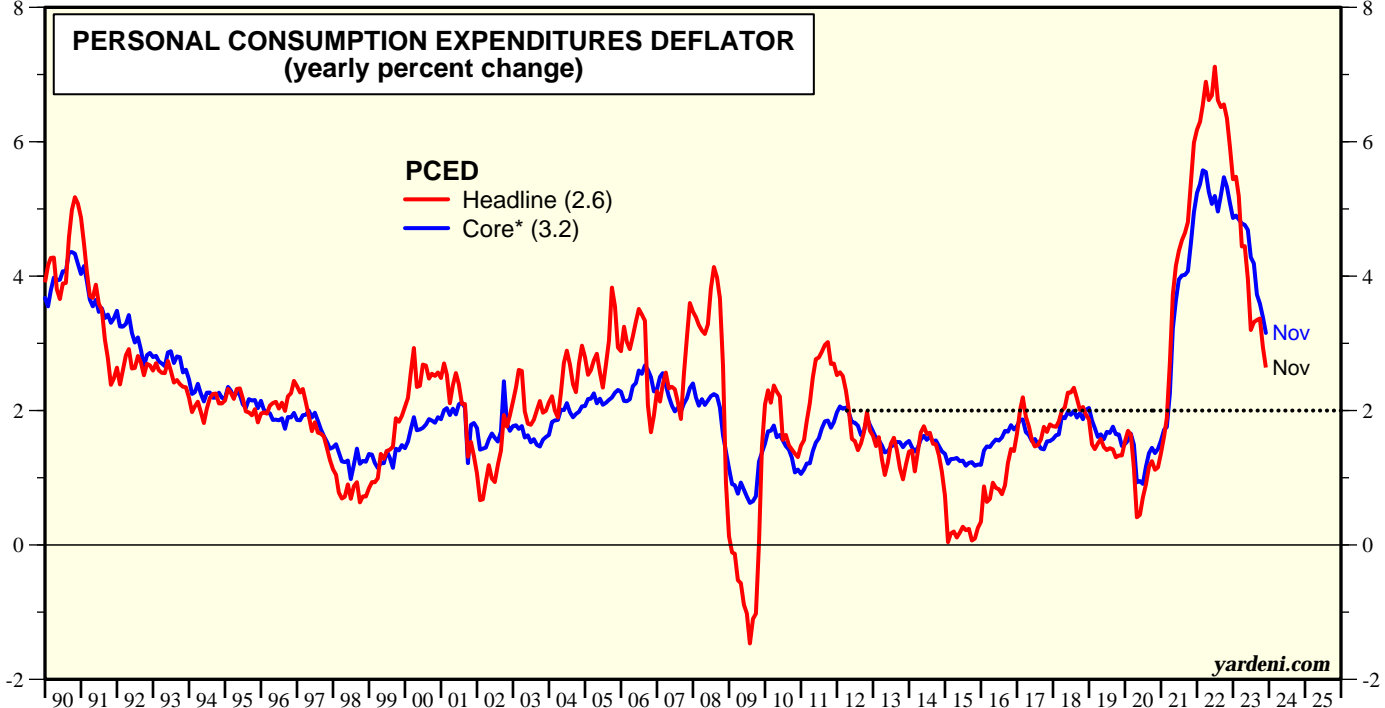

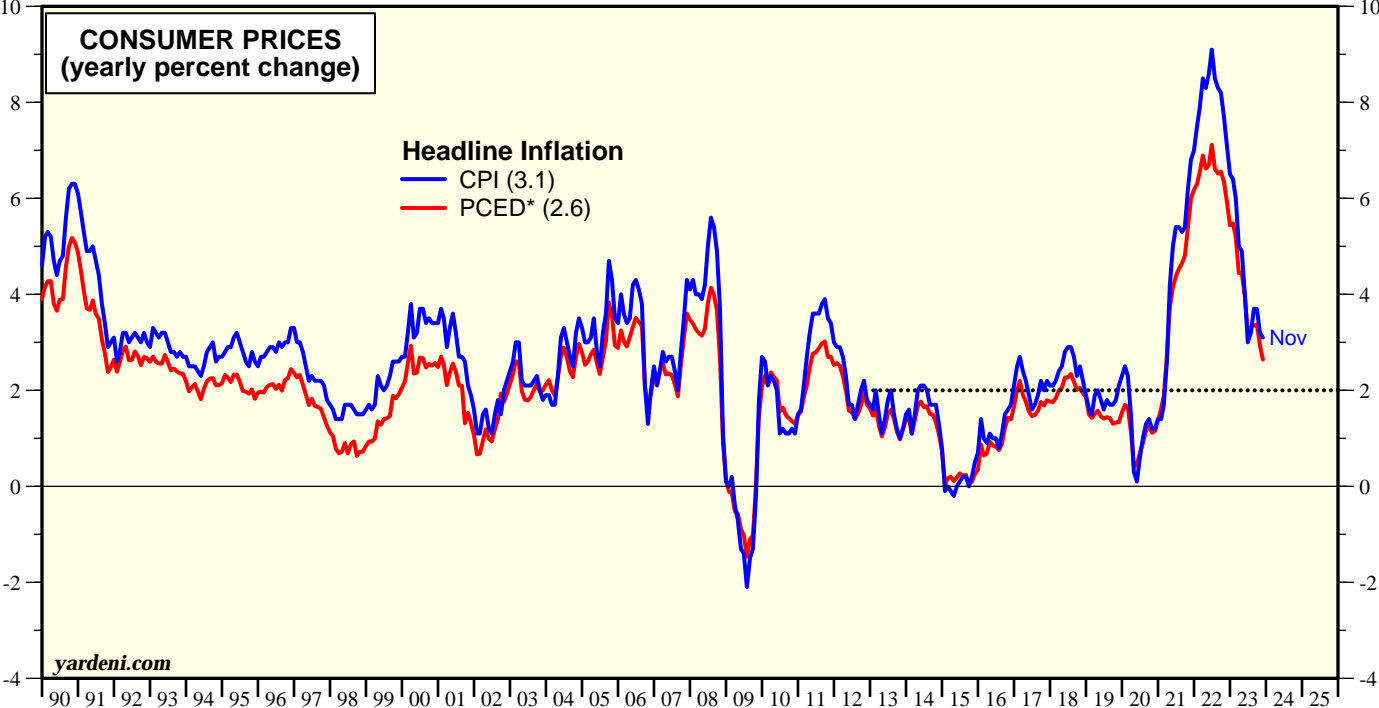

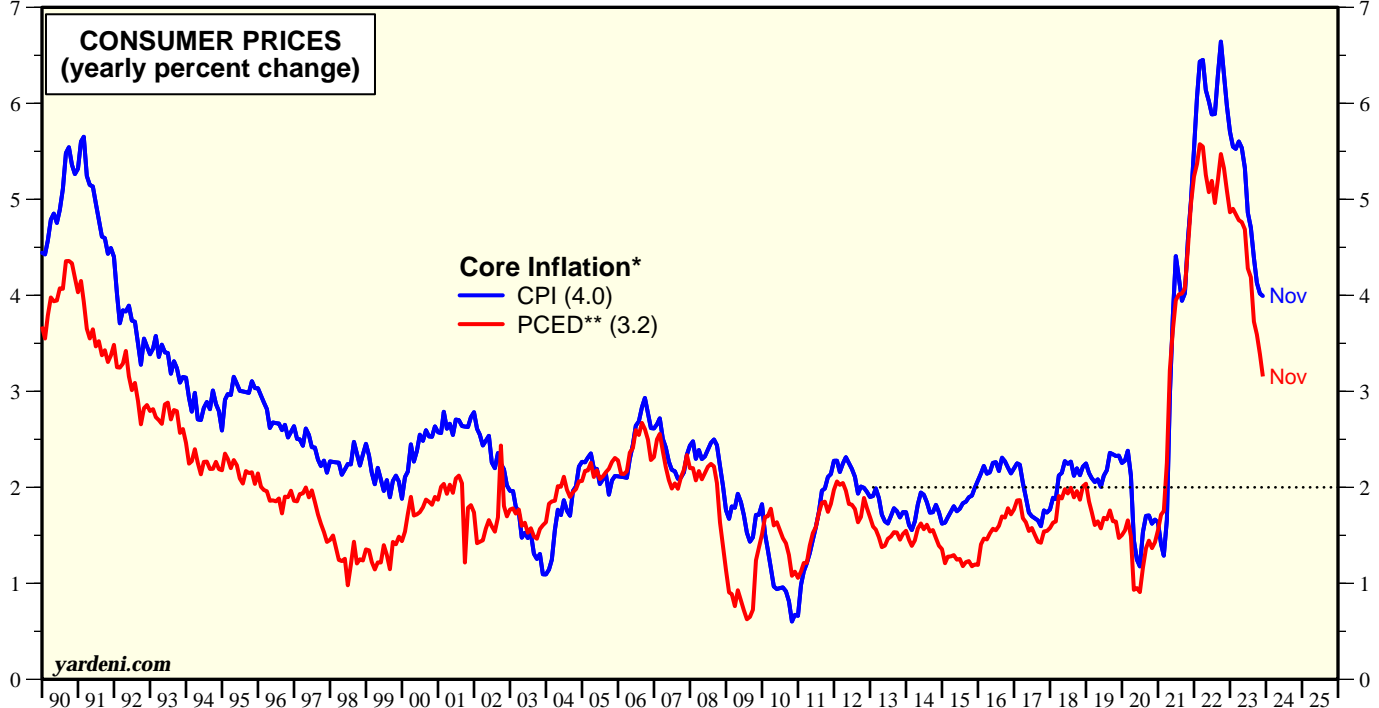

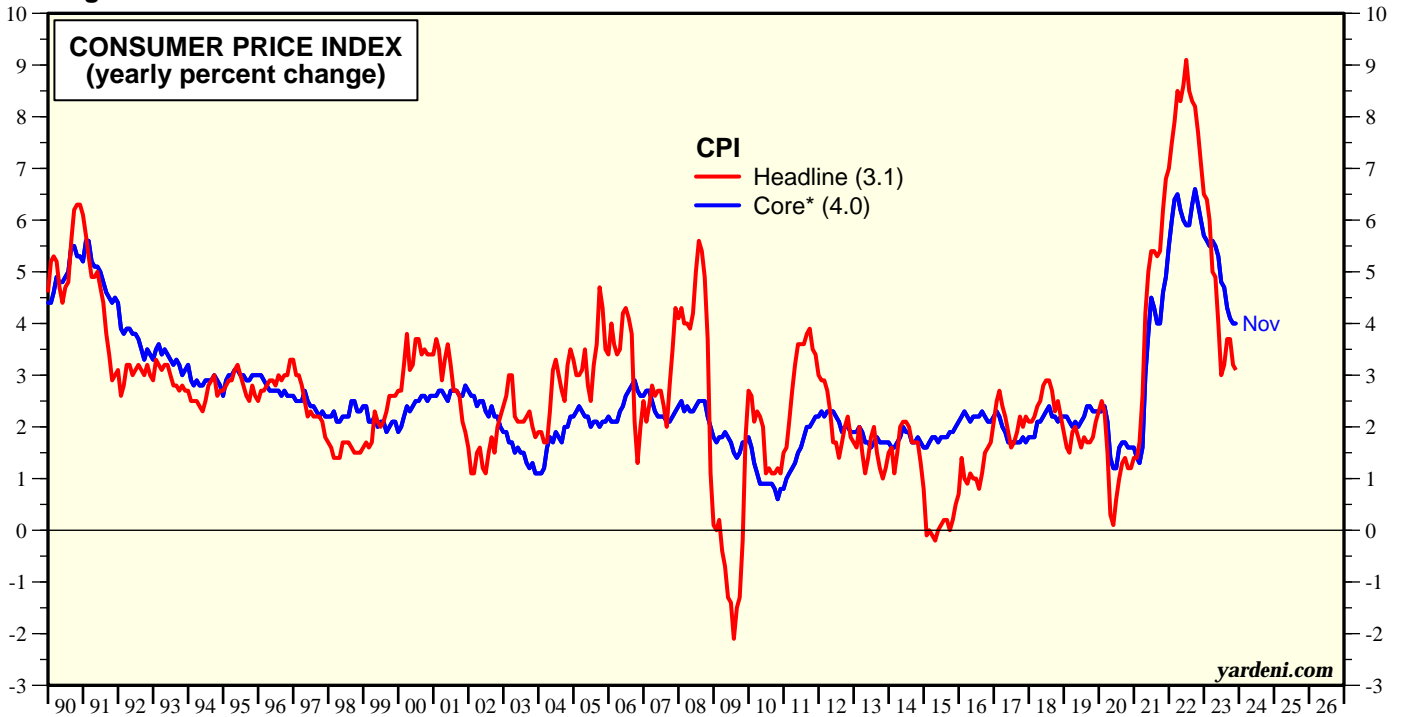

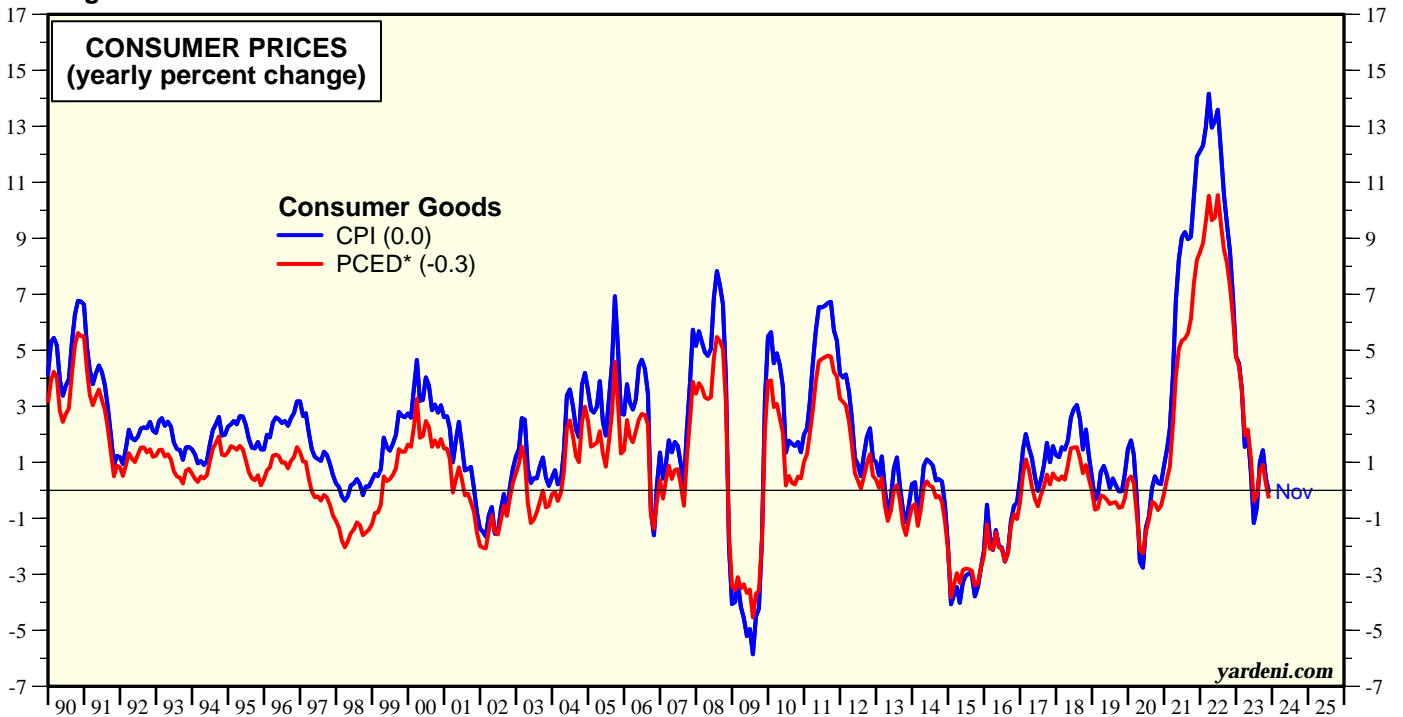

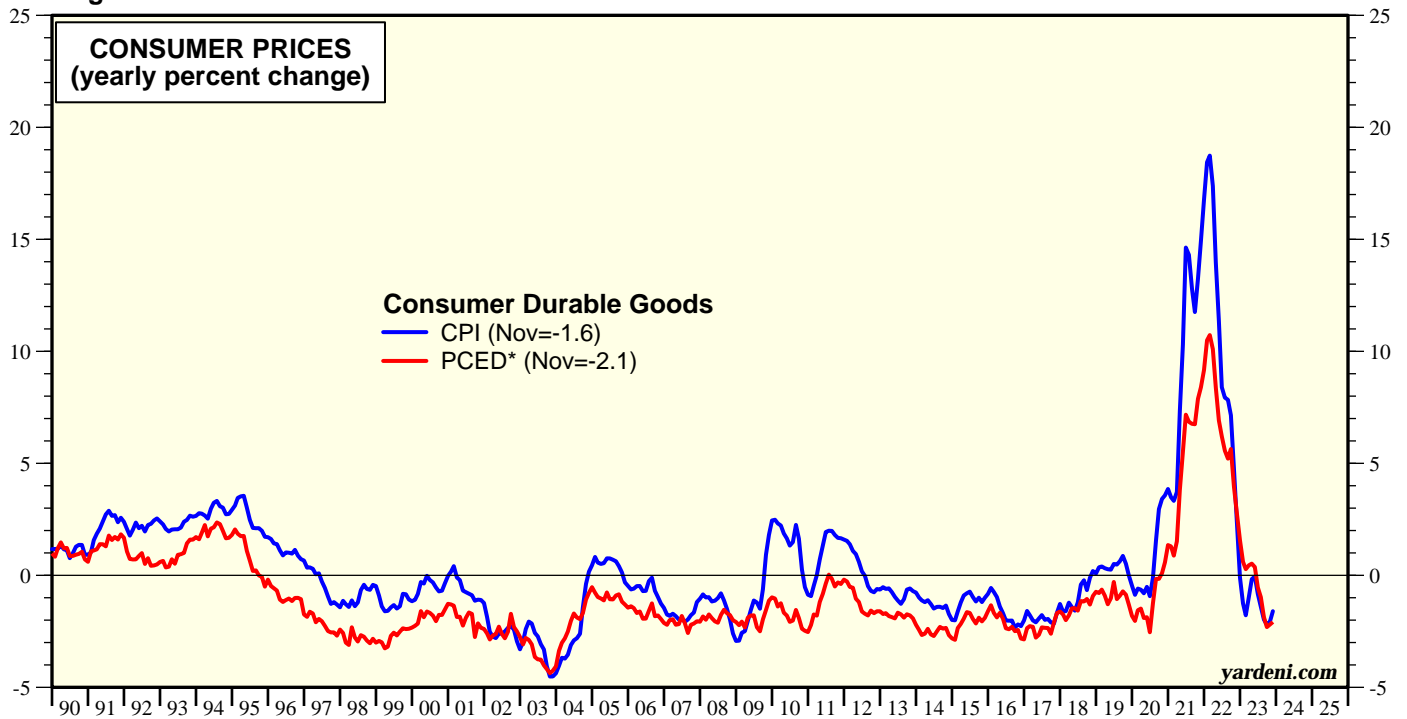

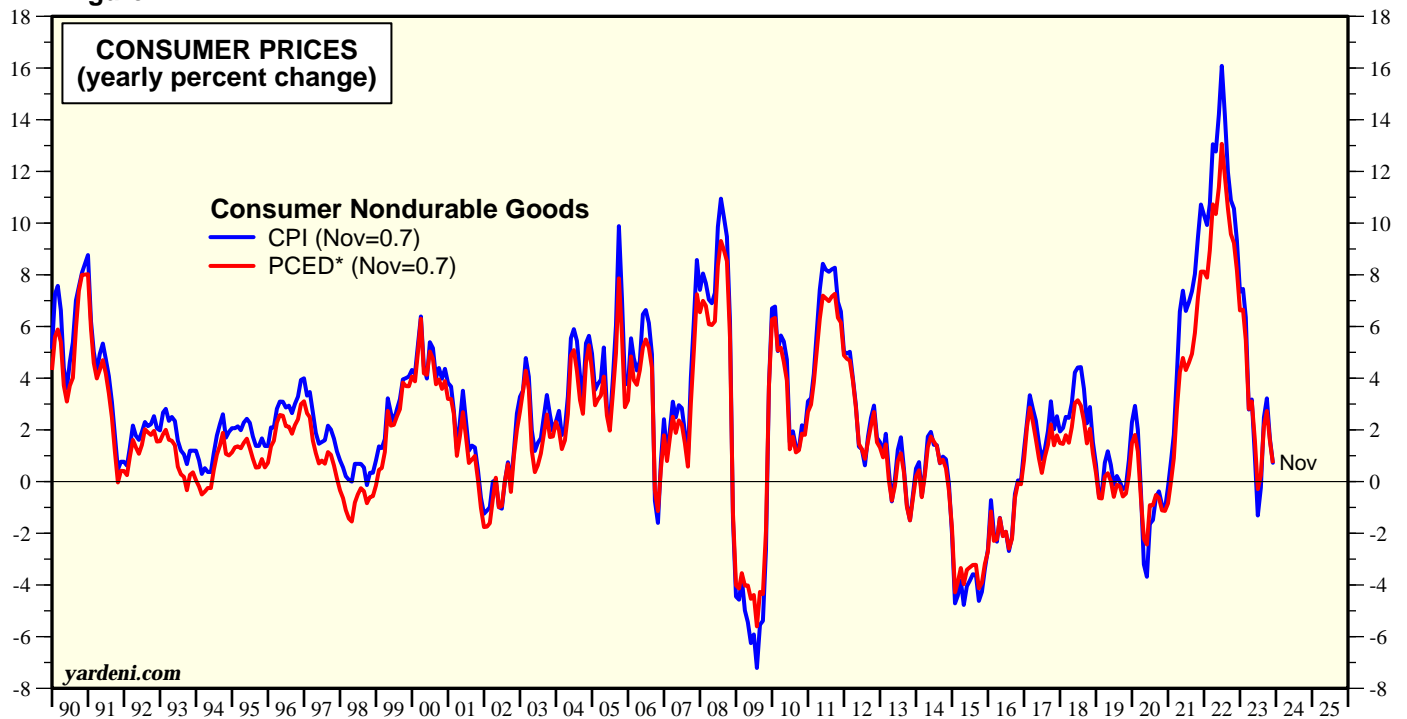
Durable & Nondurable Goods

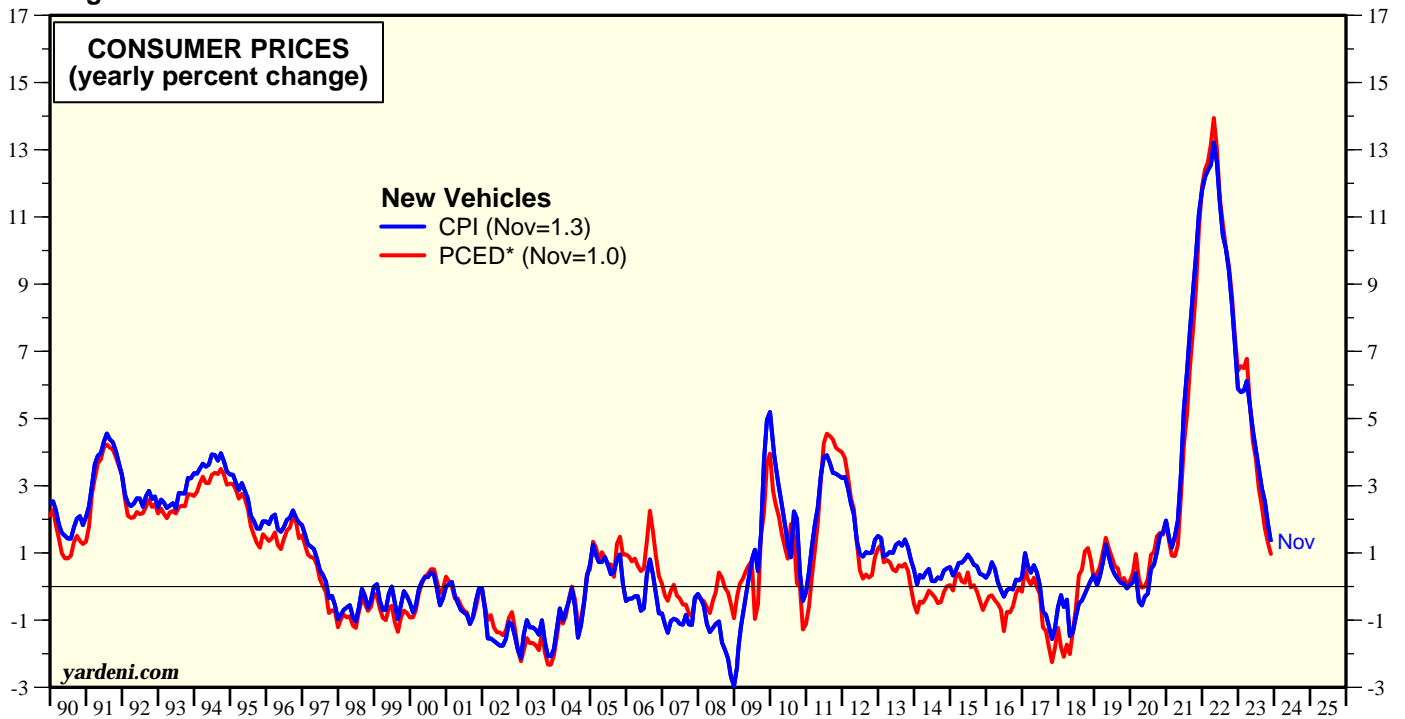

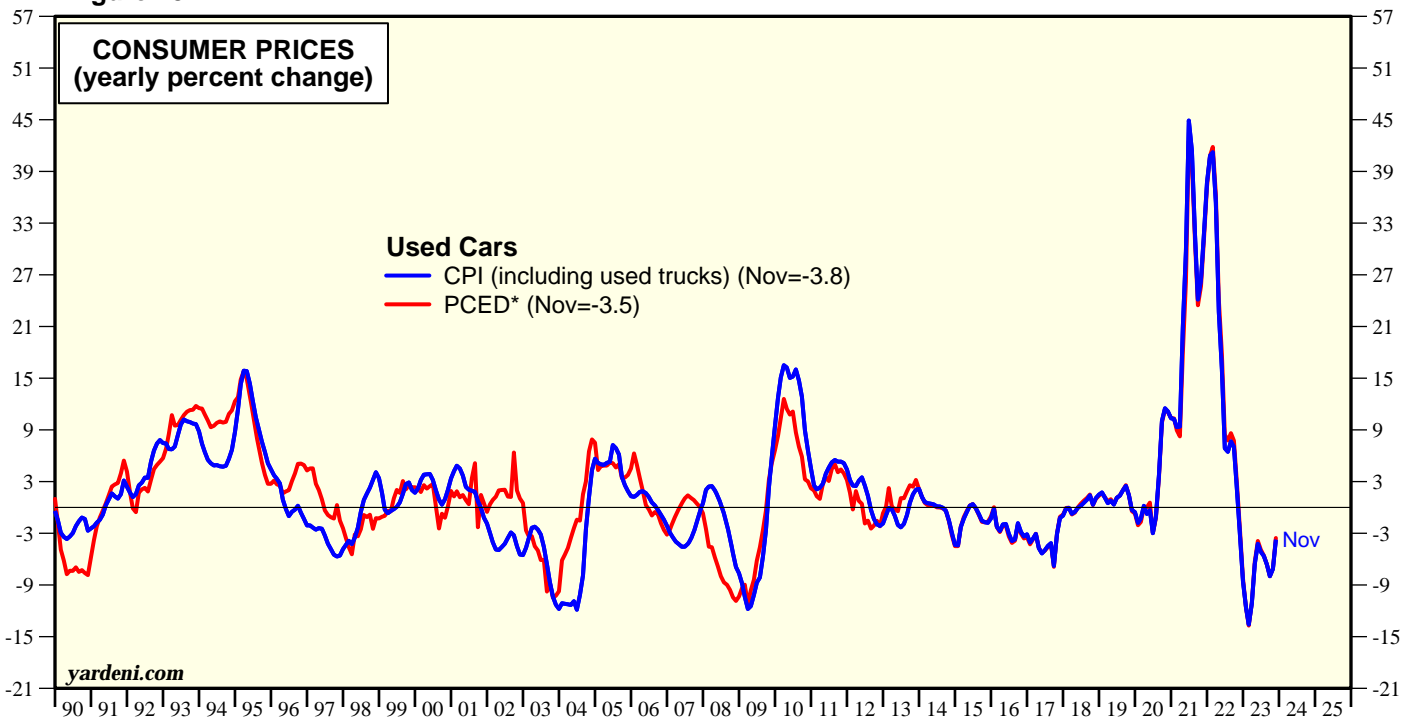

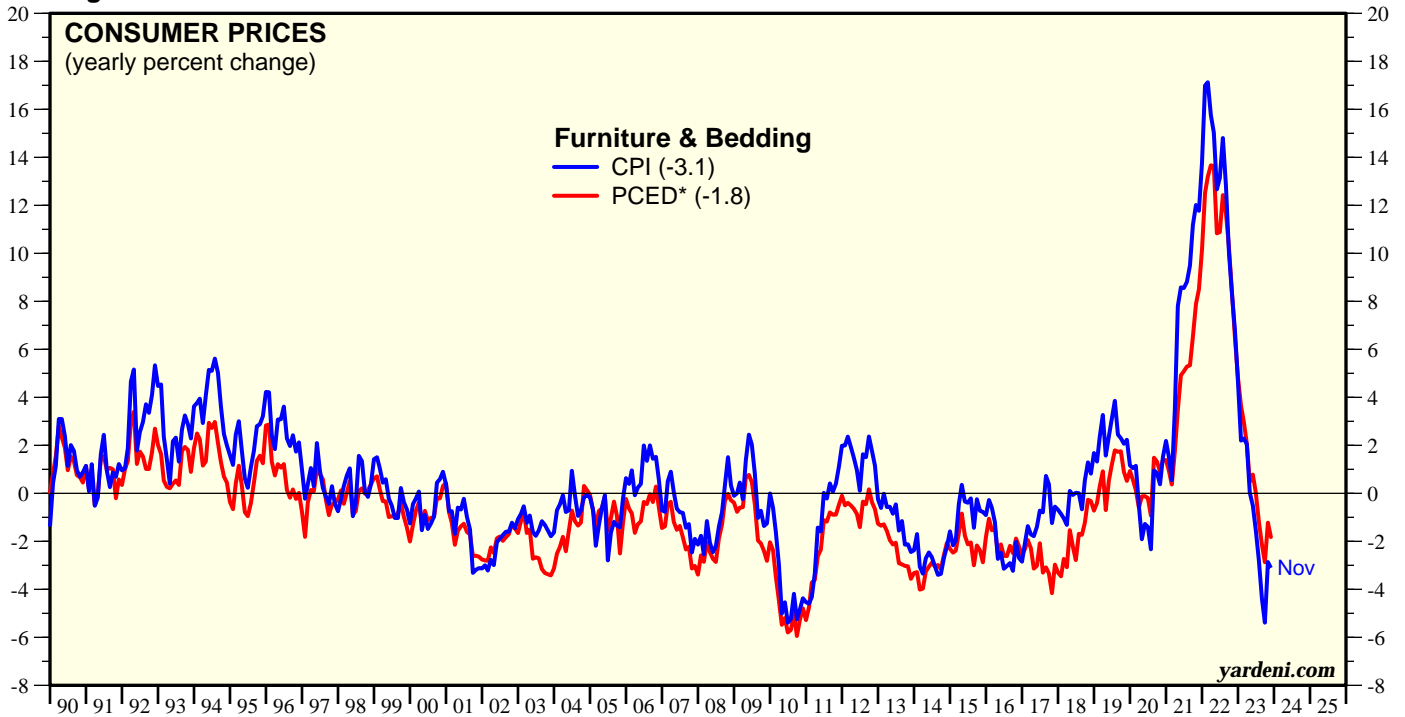

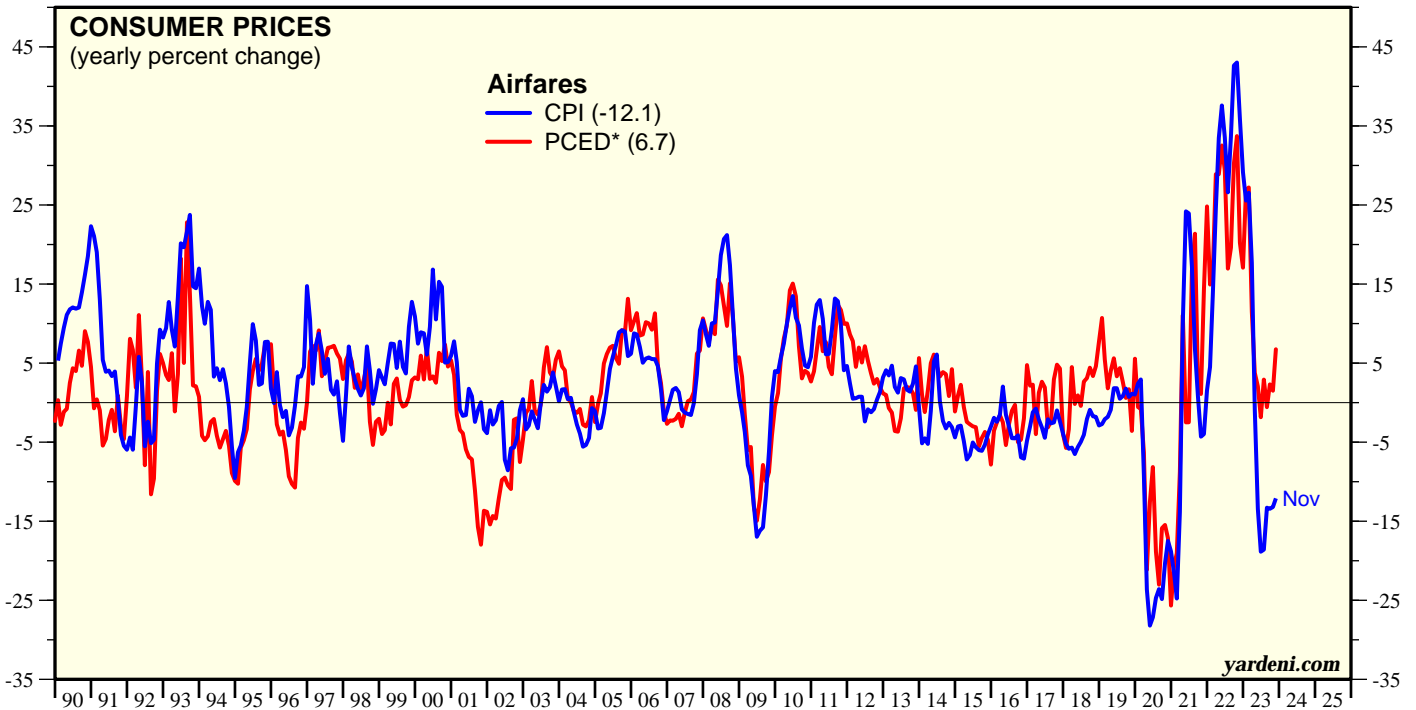

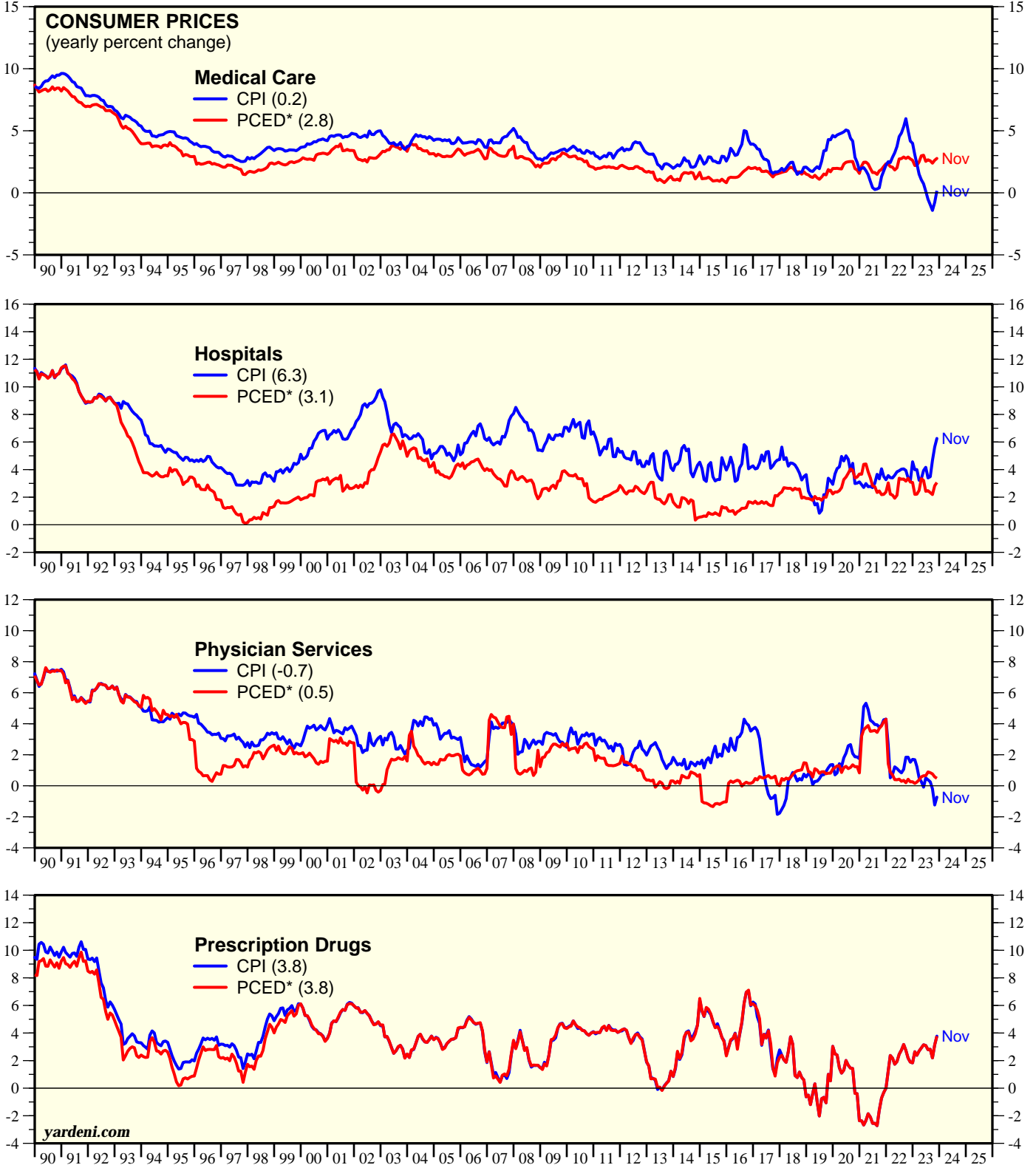

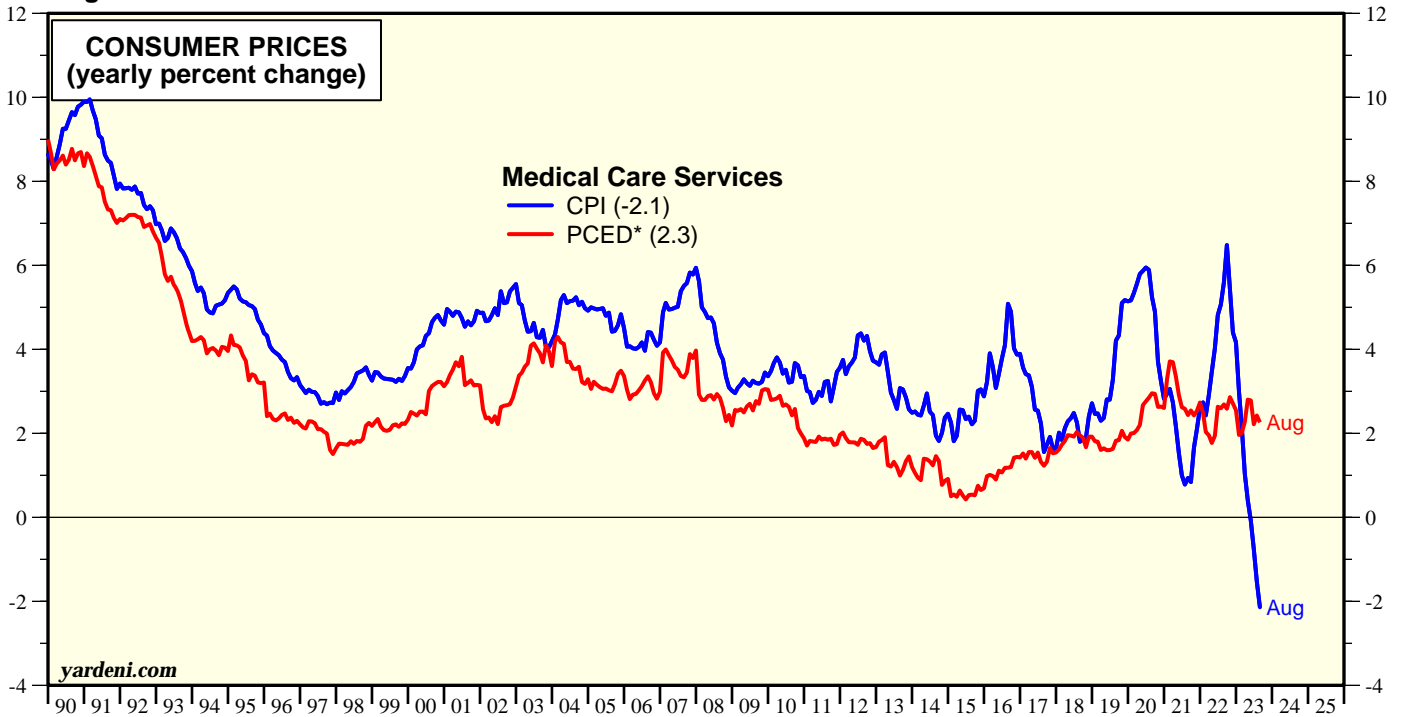

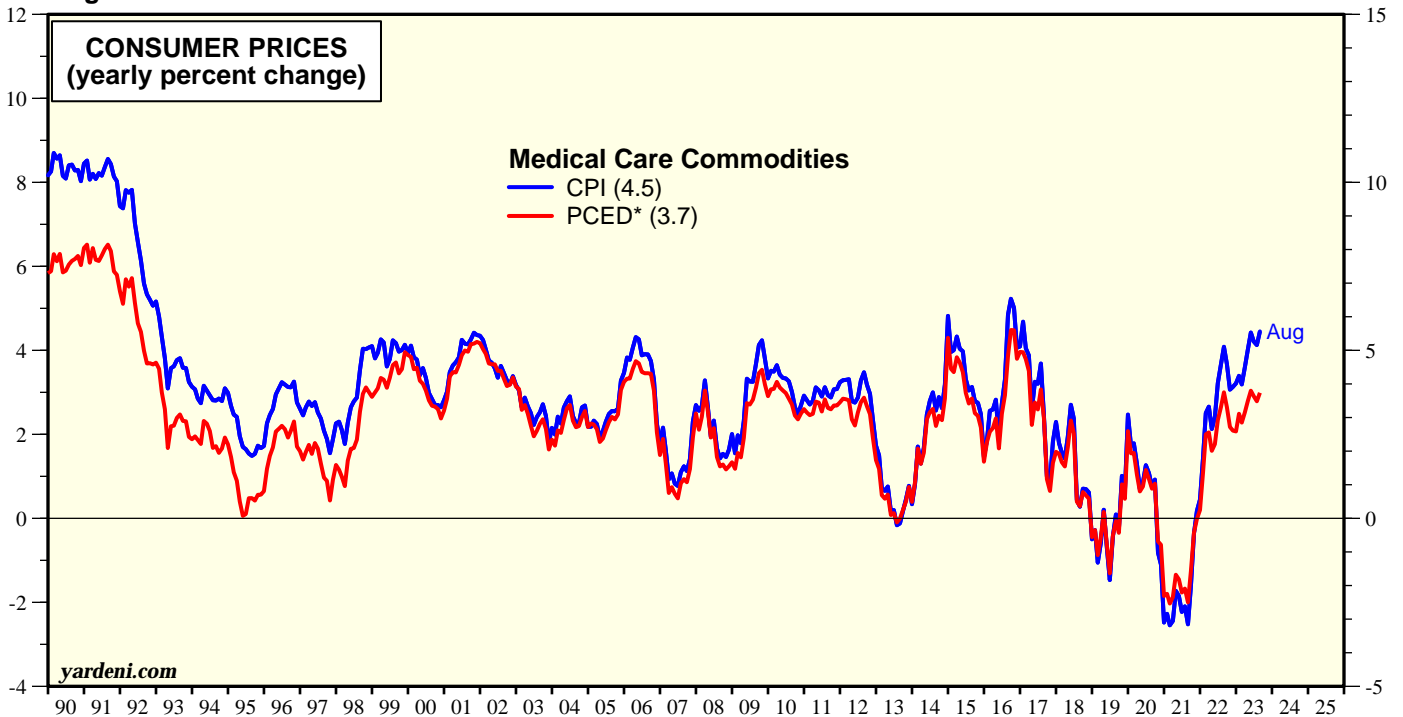

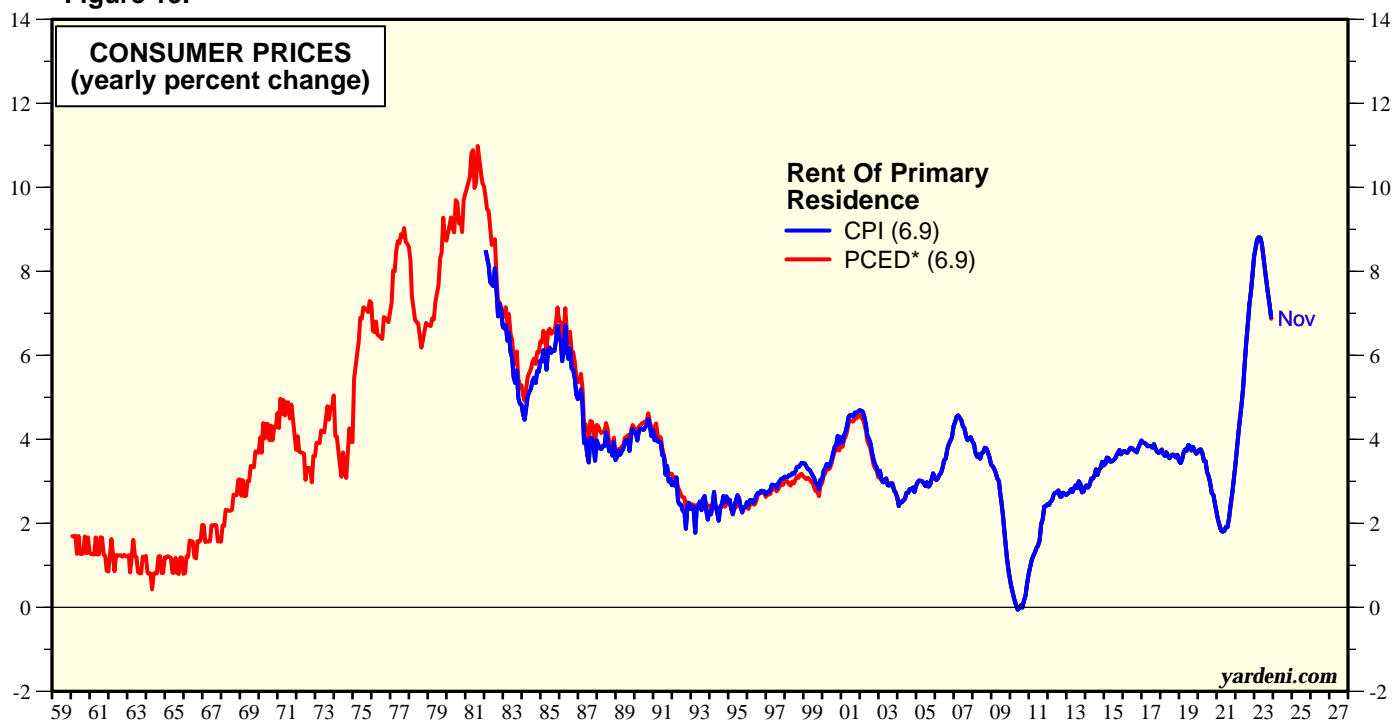

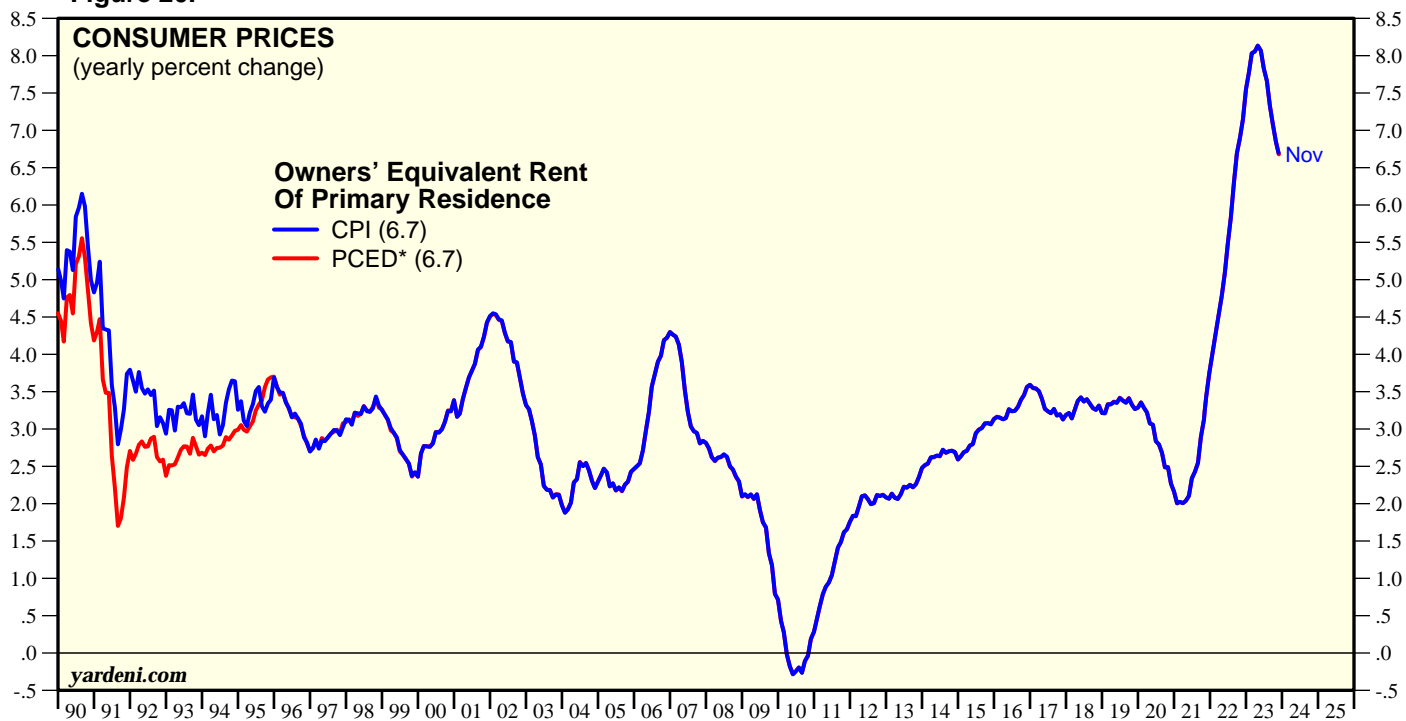

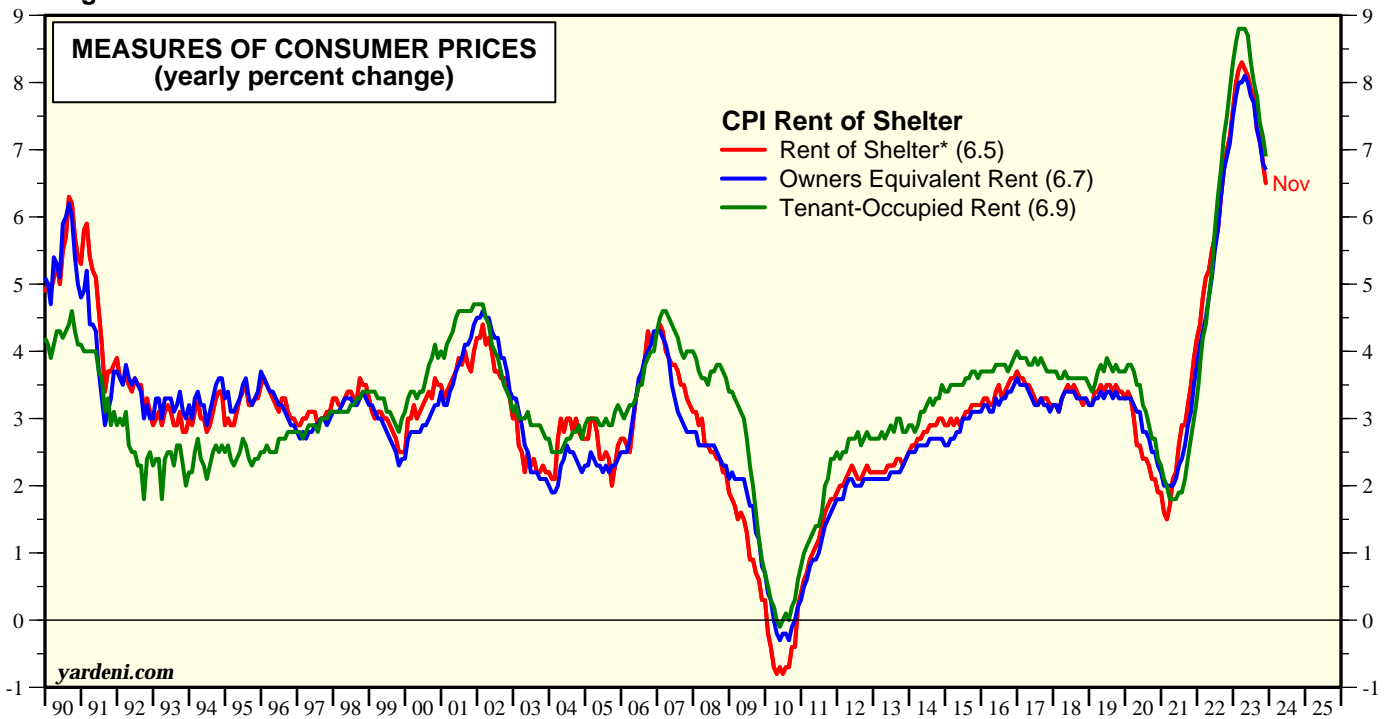

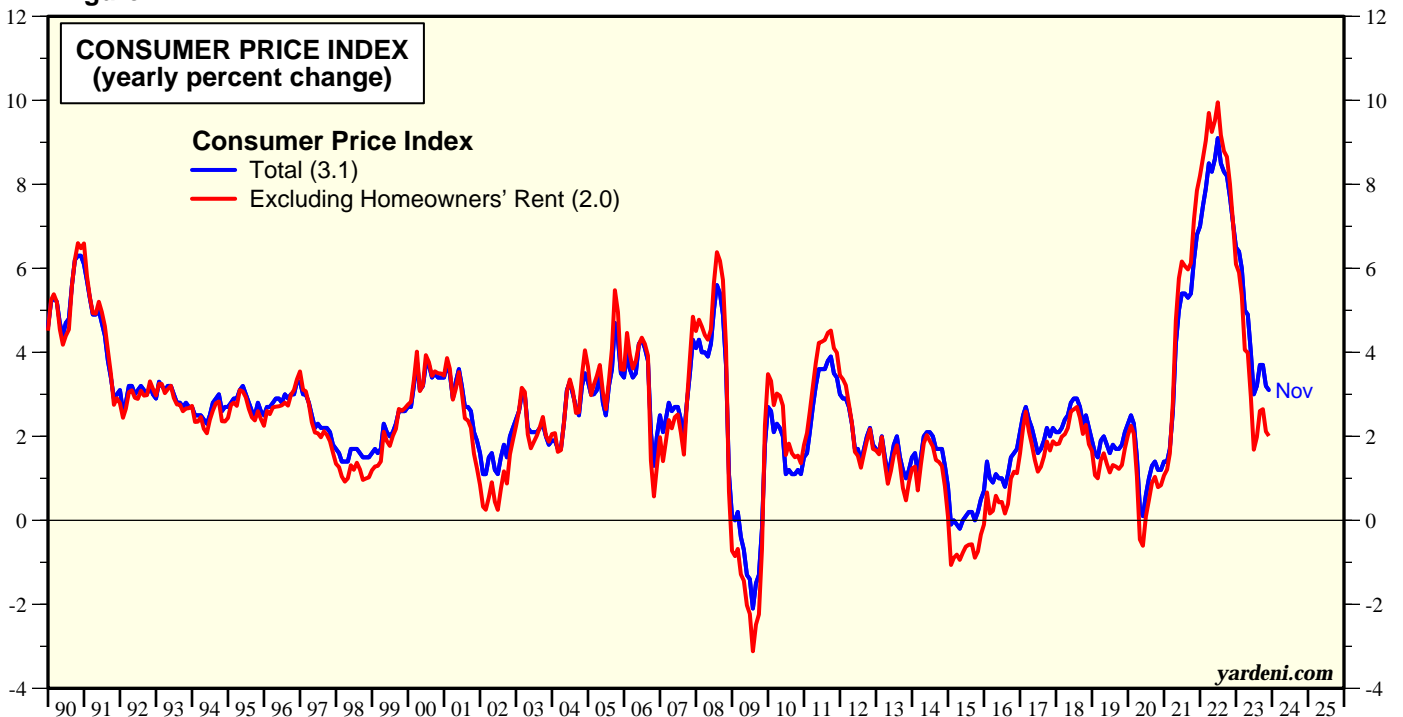

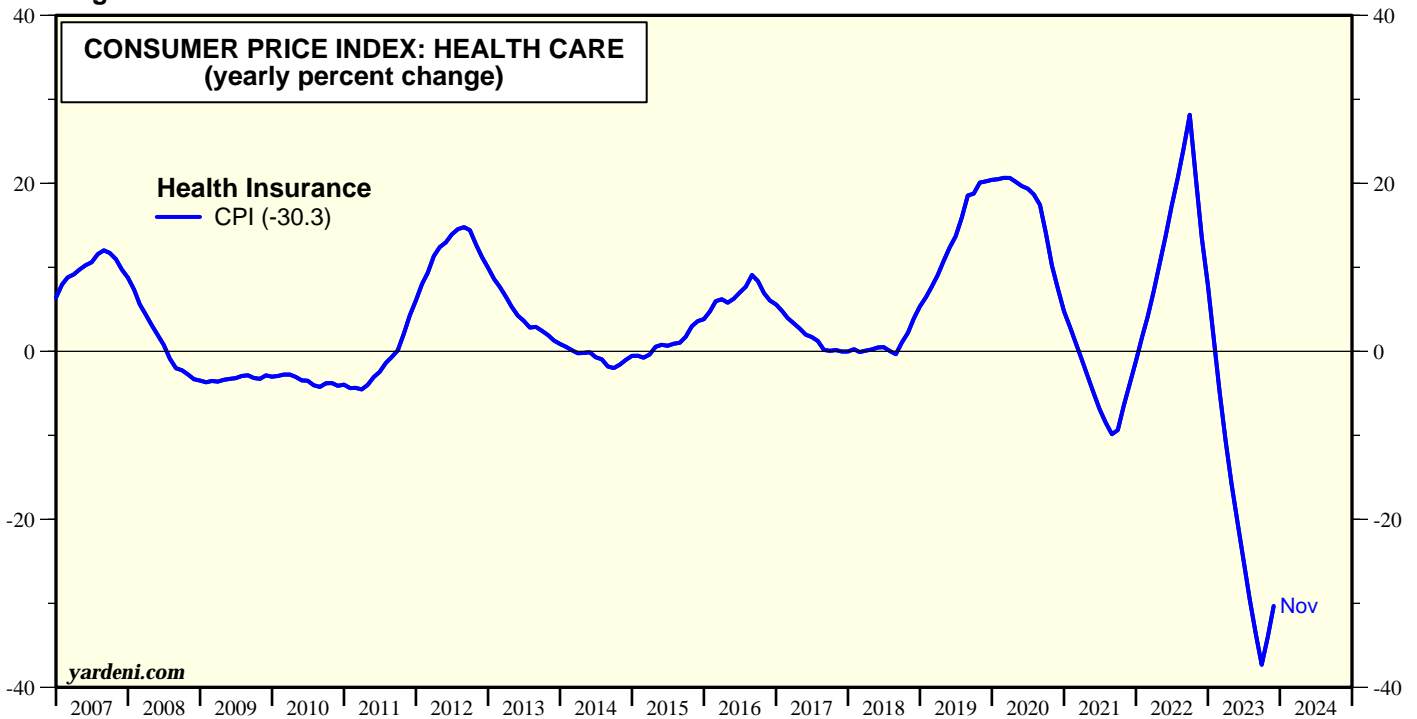

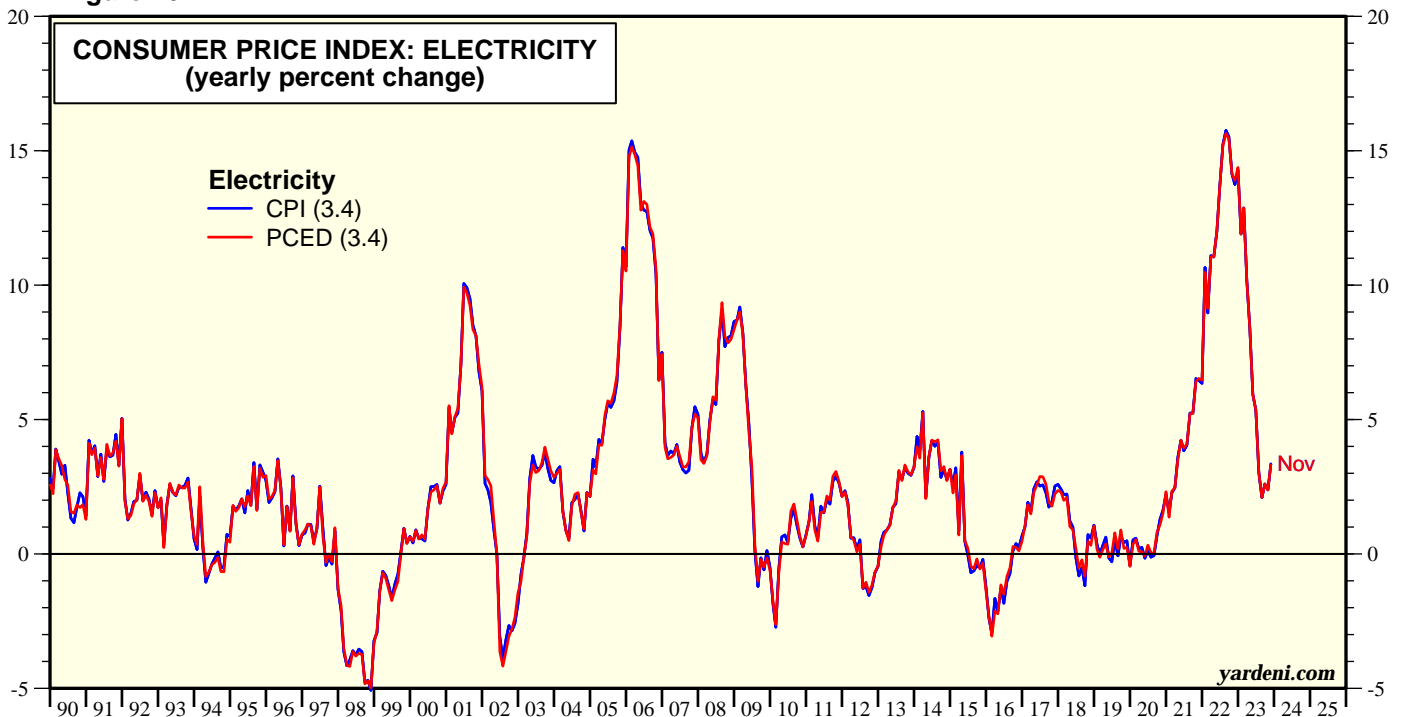

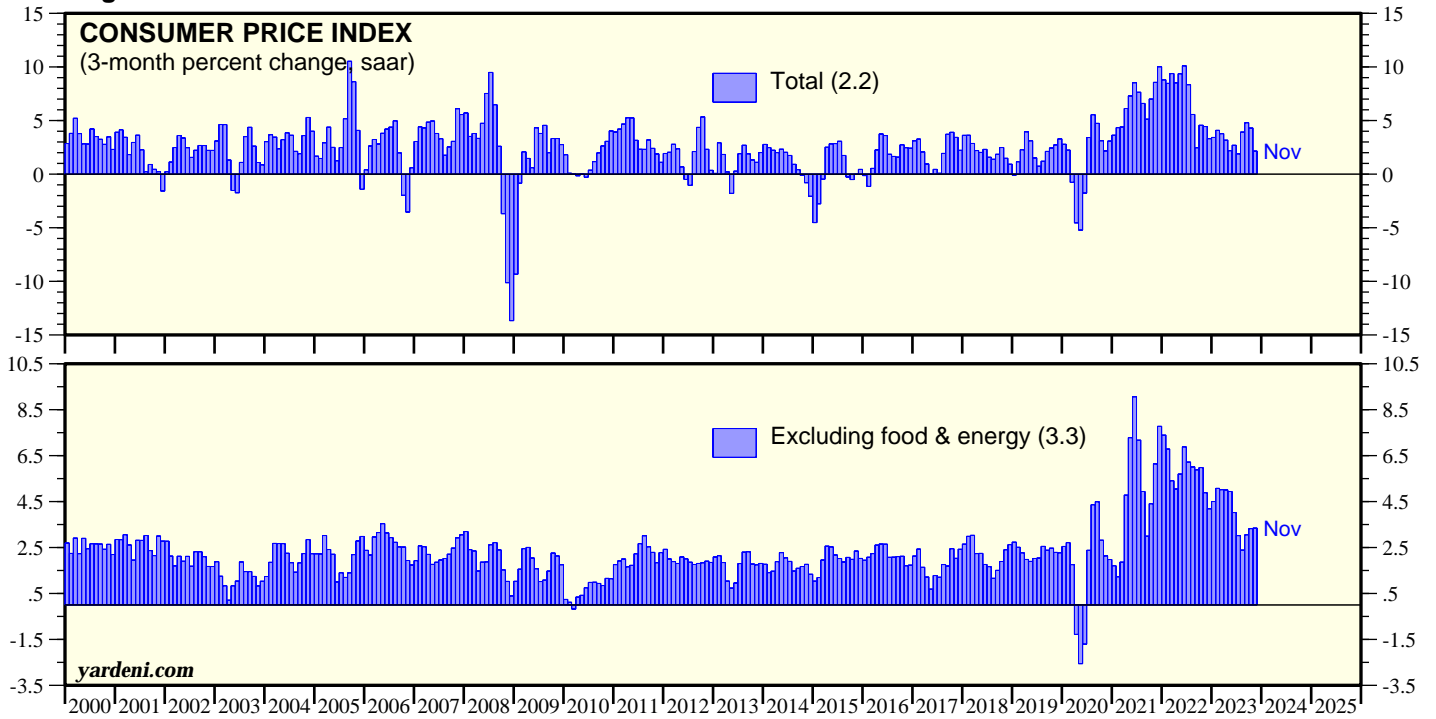

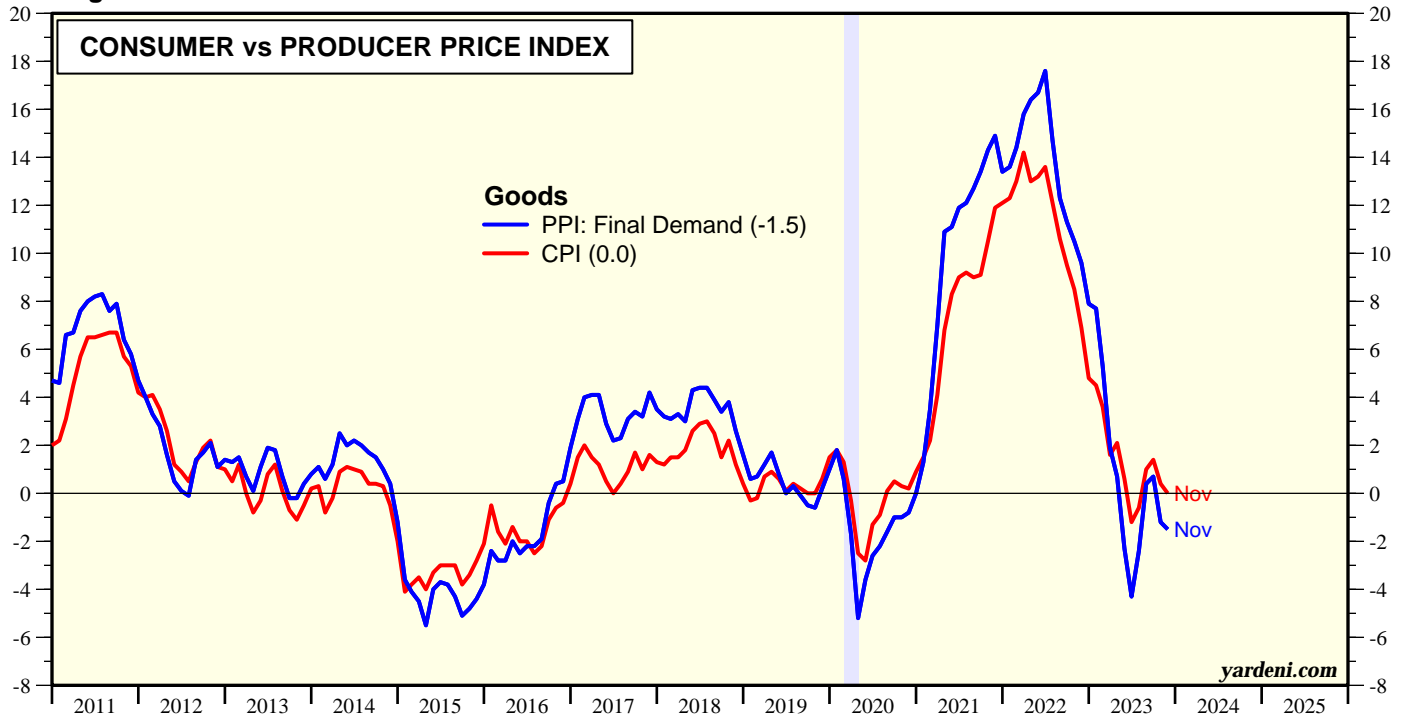

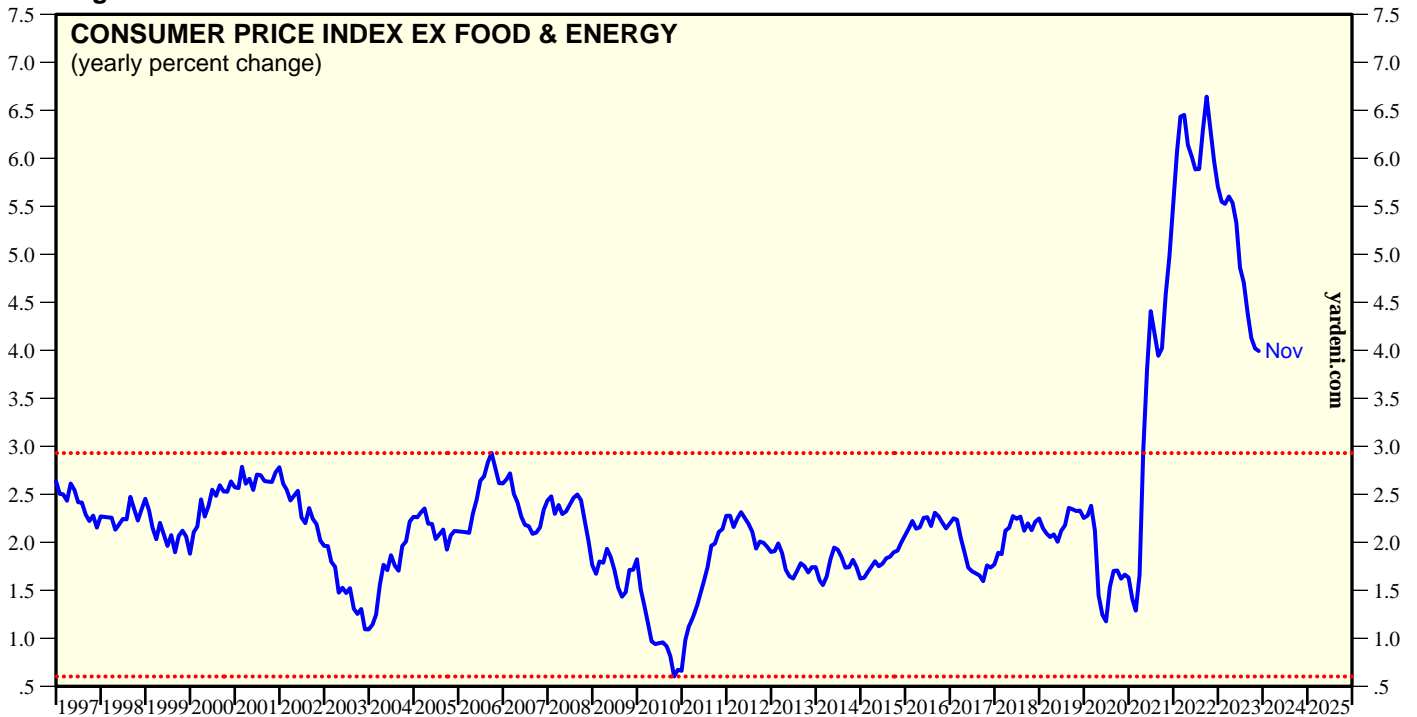

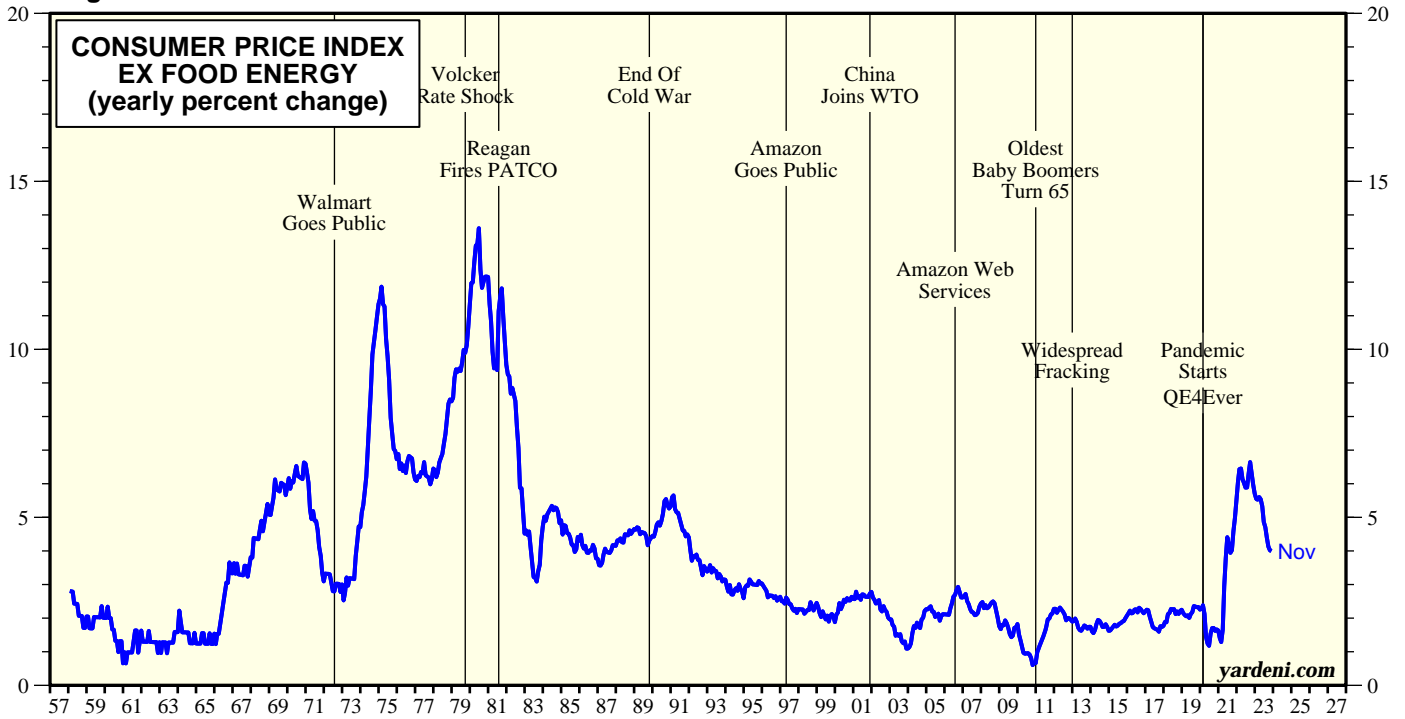

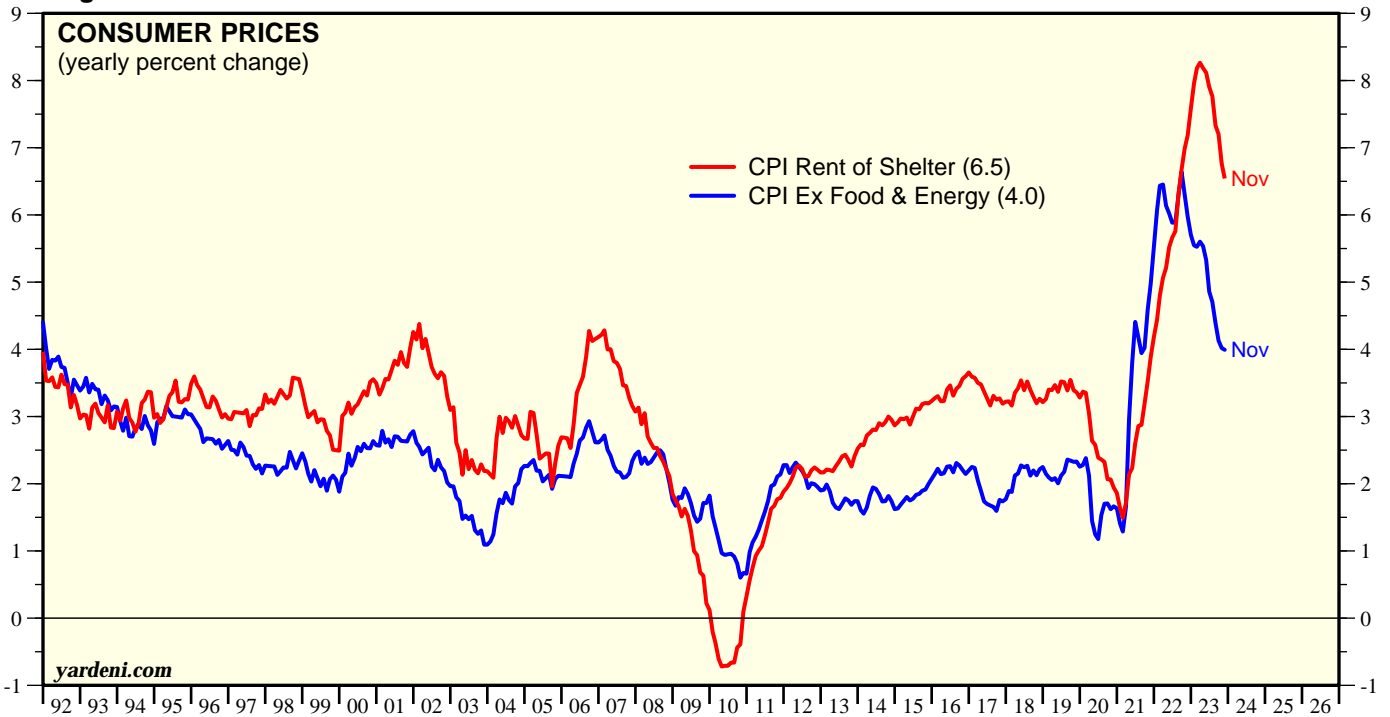

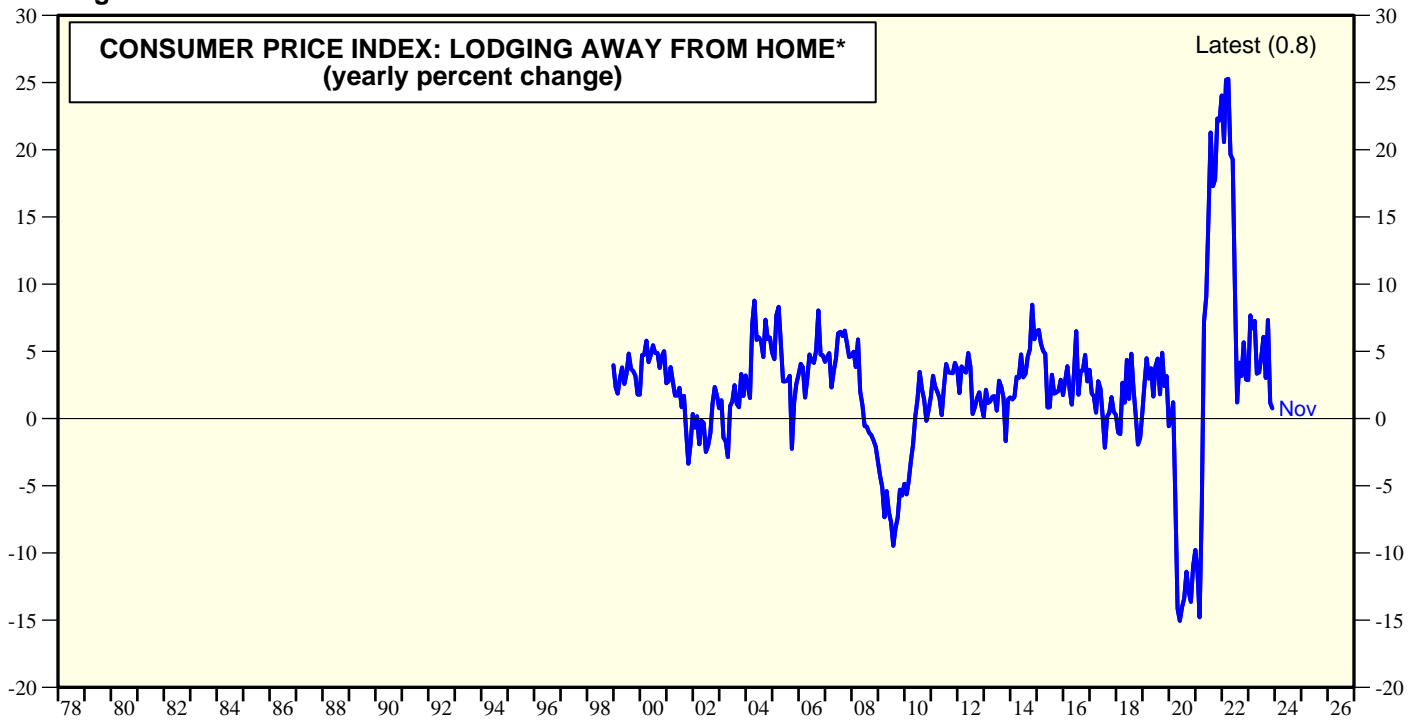

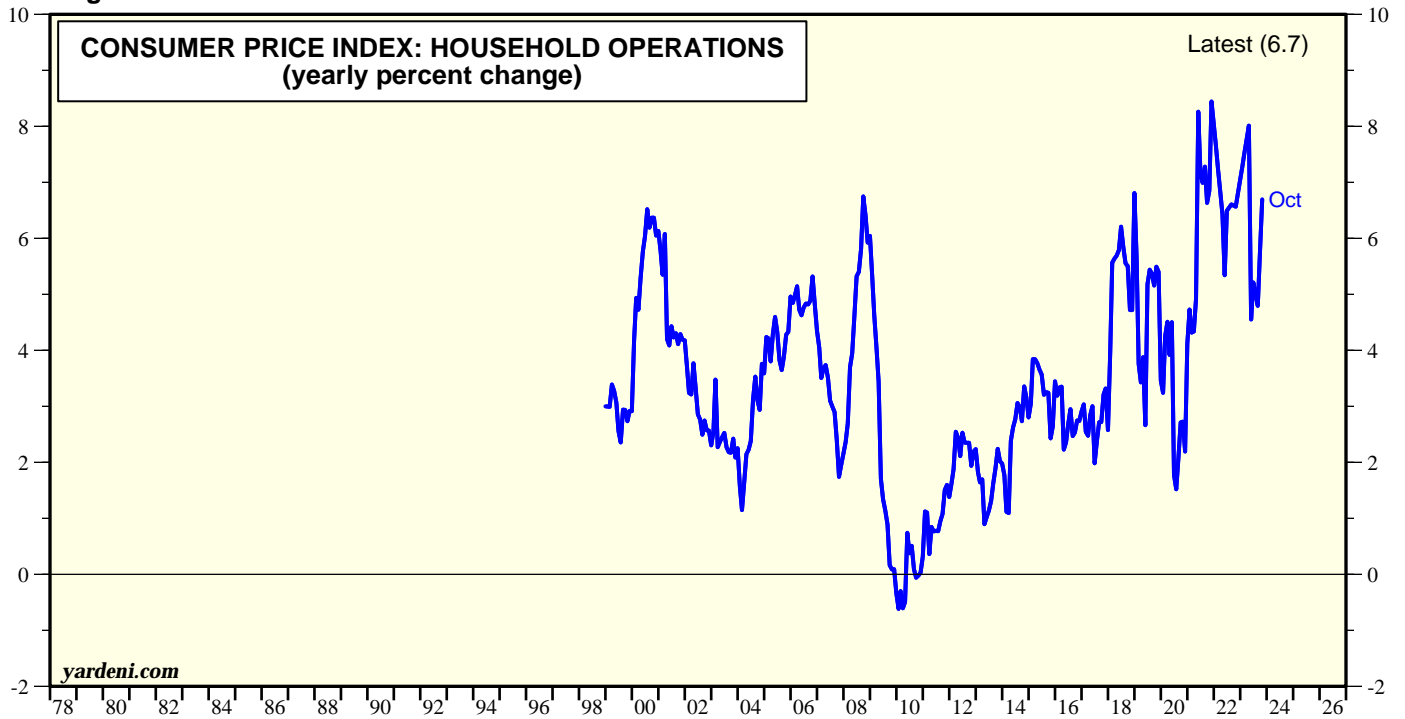
