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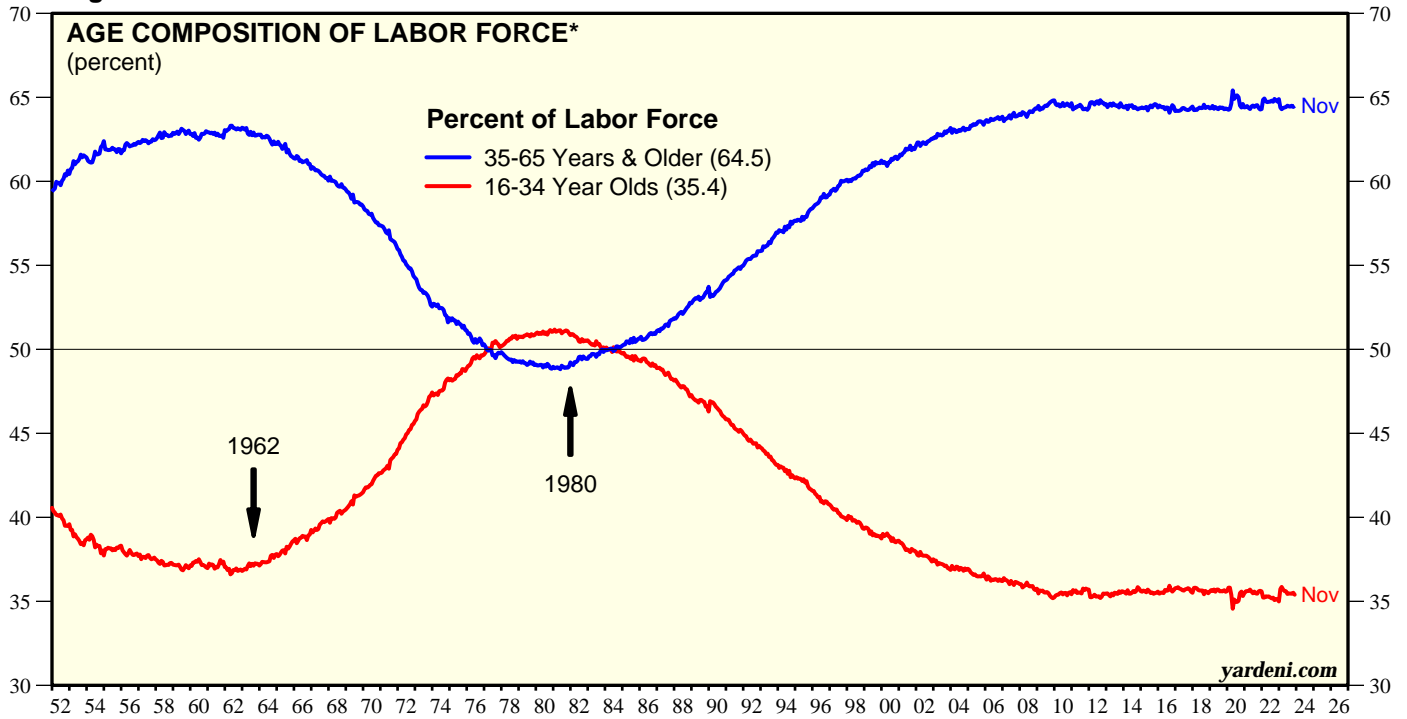

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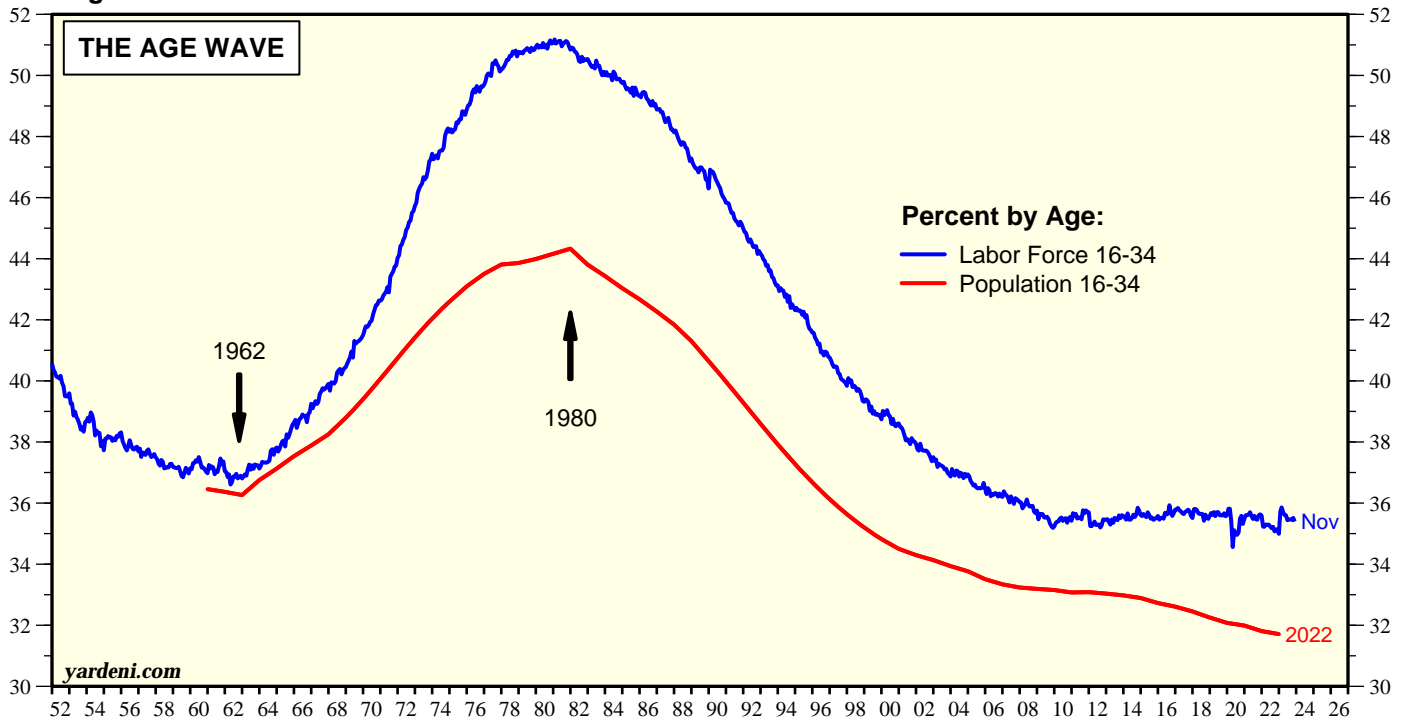

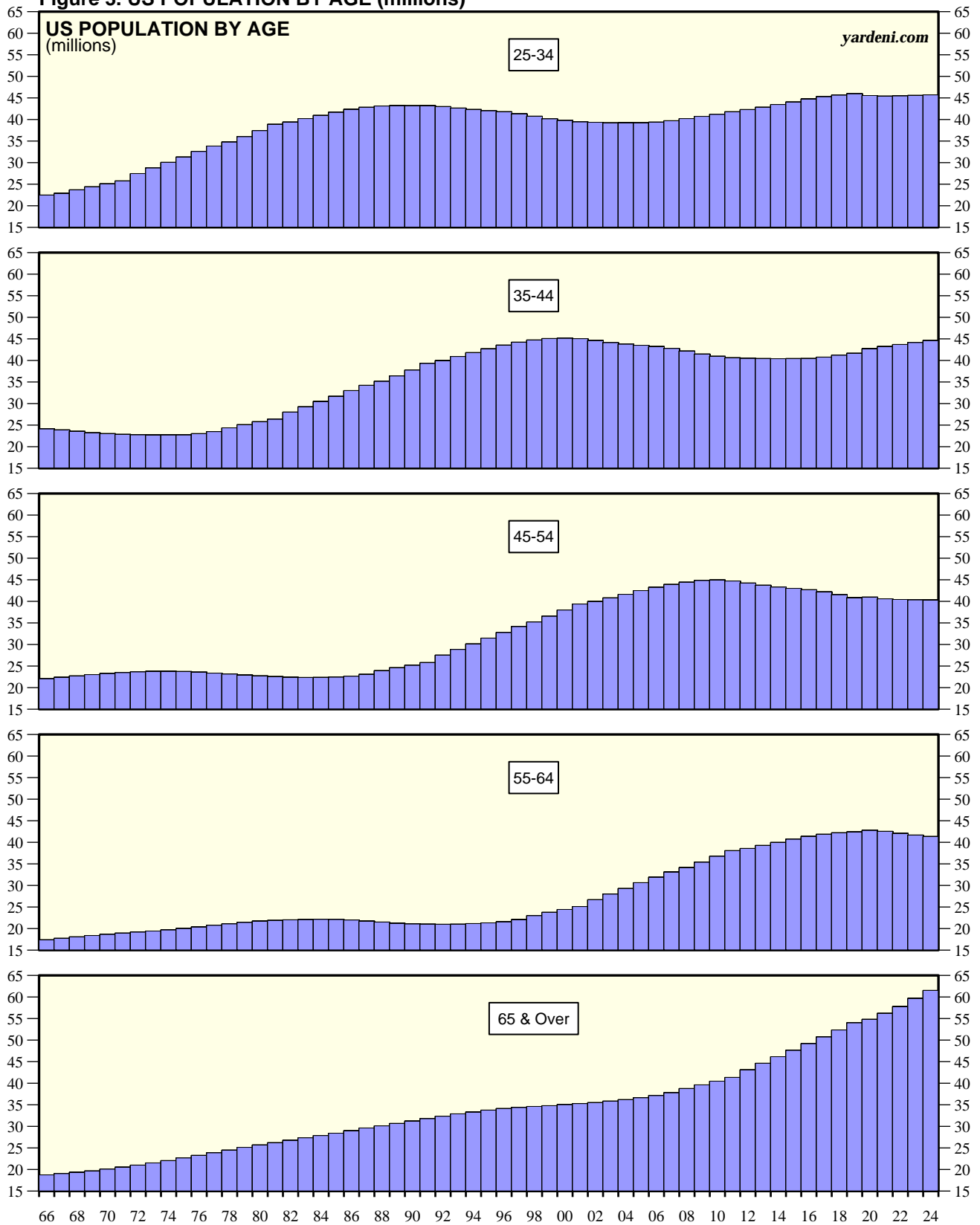

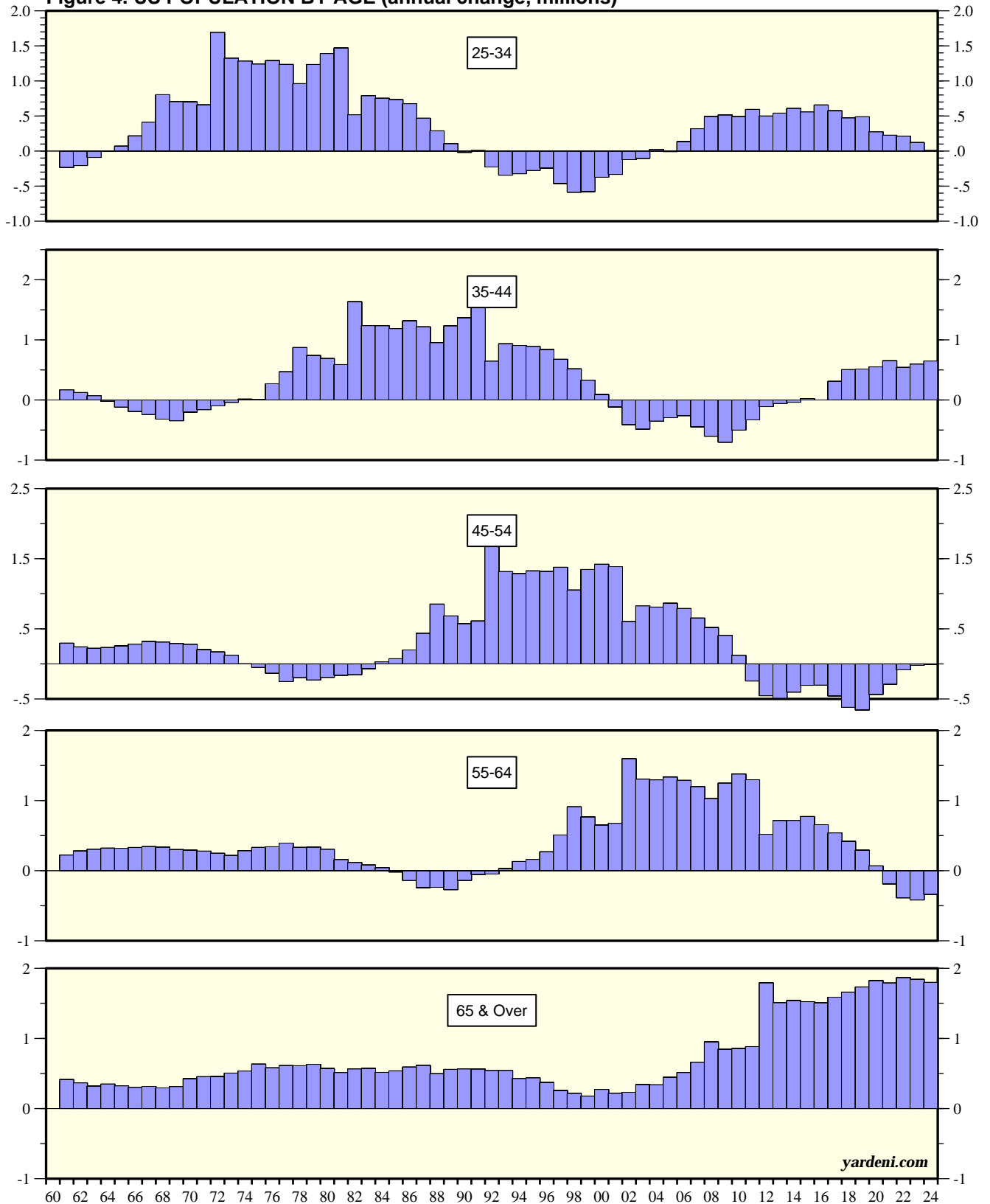
Figure 3. US POPULATION BY AGE (millions)

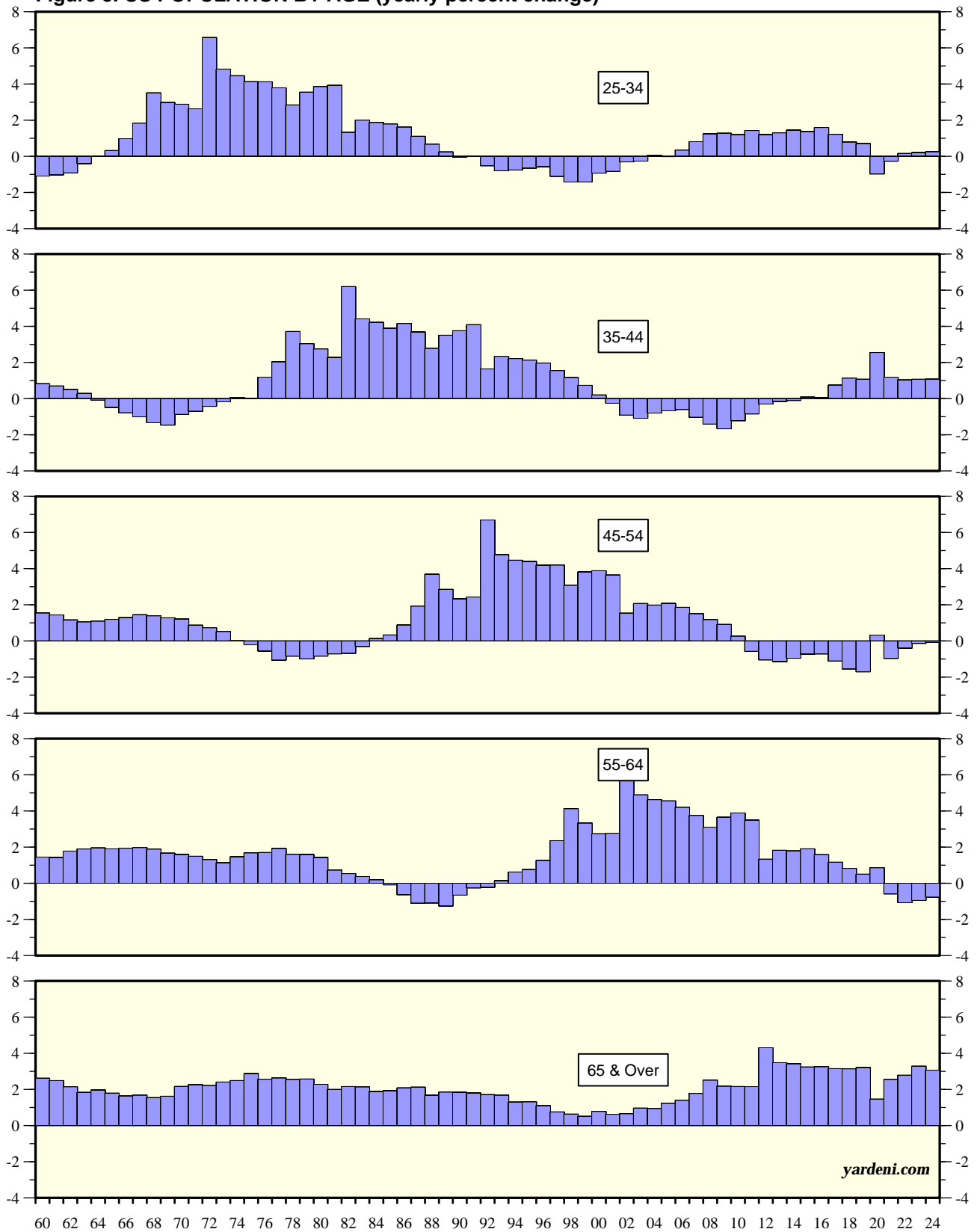
Figure 4. US POPULATION BY AGE (annual change, millions)

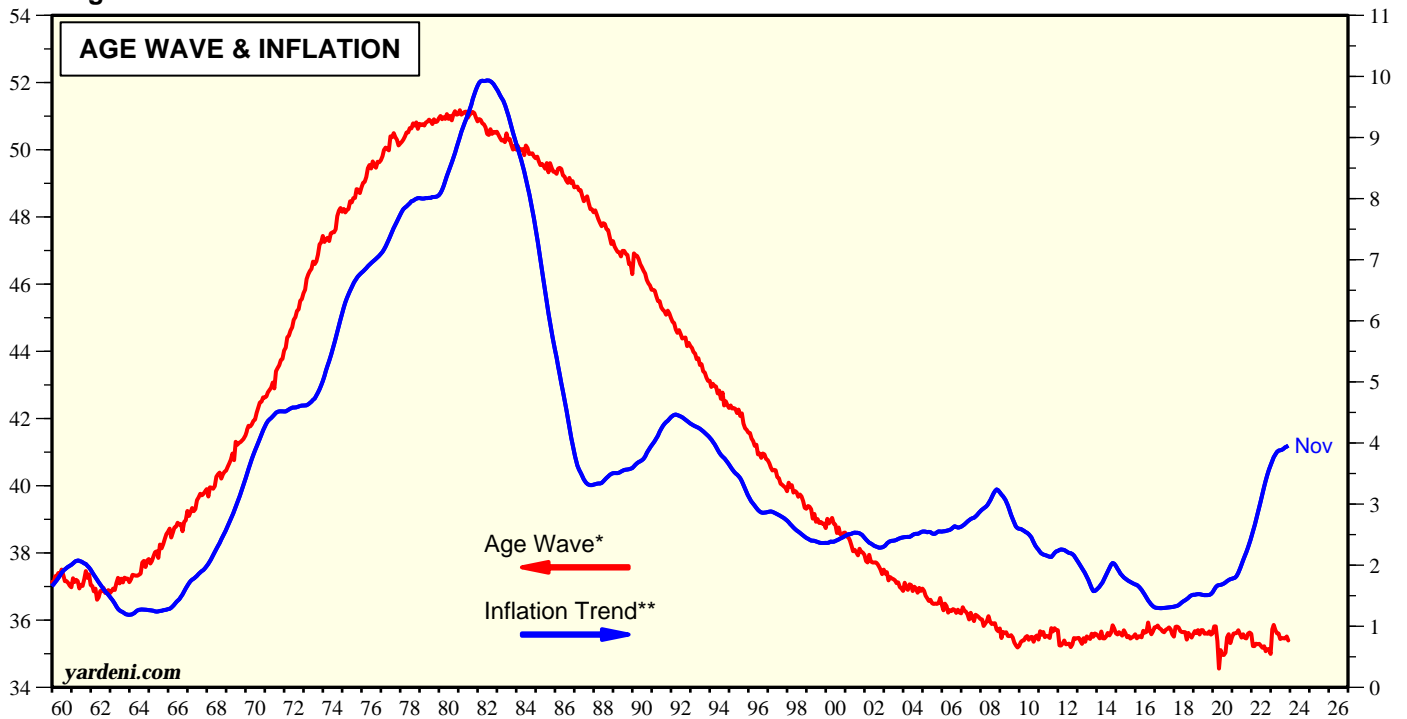
Figure 5. US POPULATION BY AGE (yearly percent change)

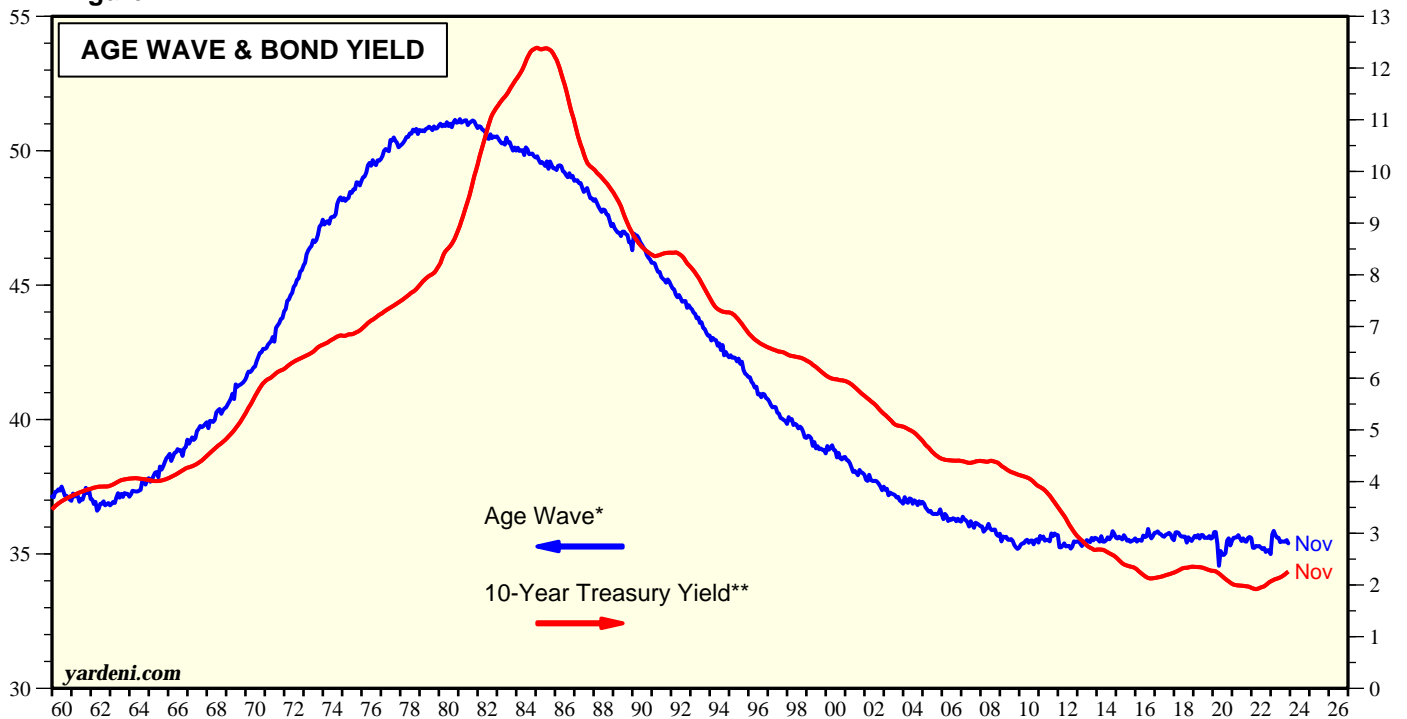

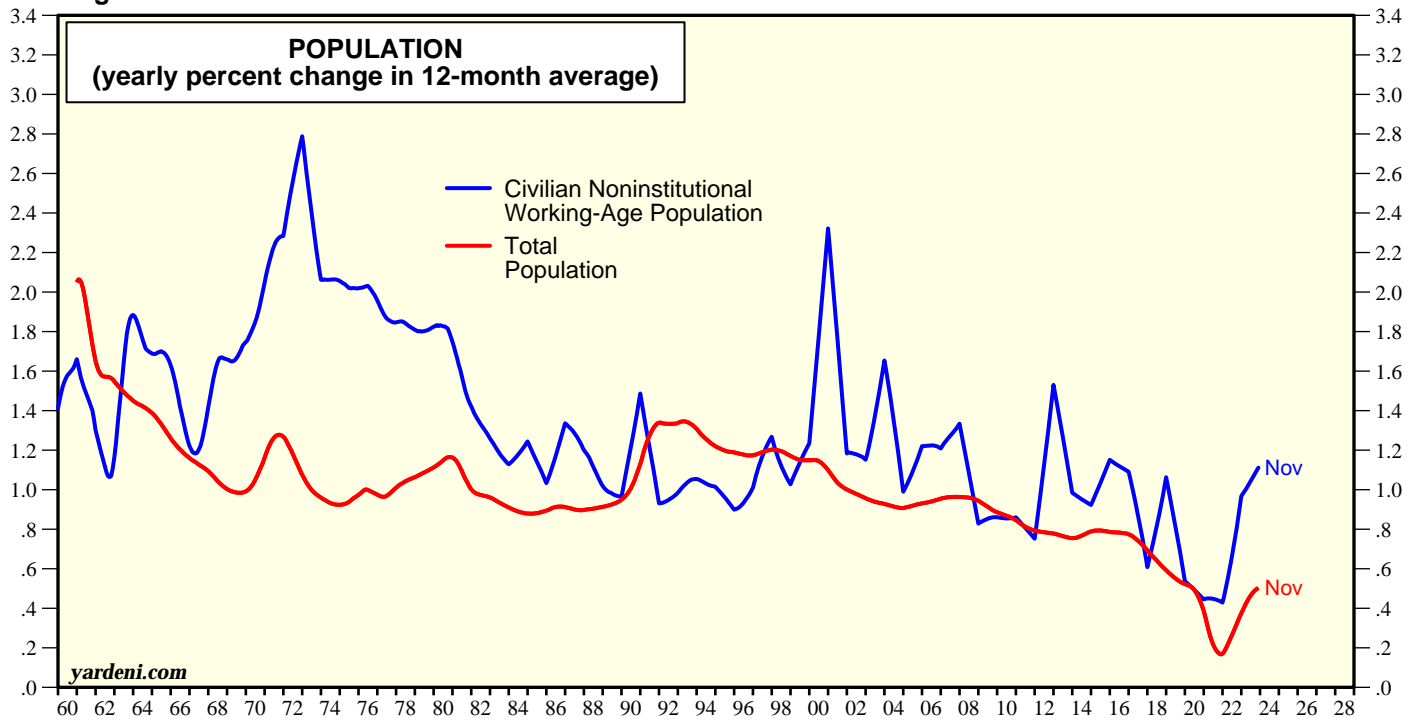

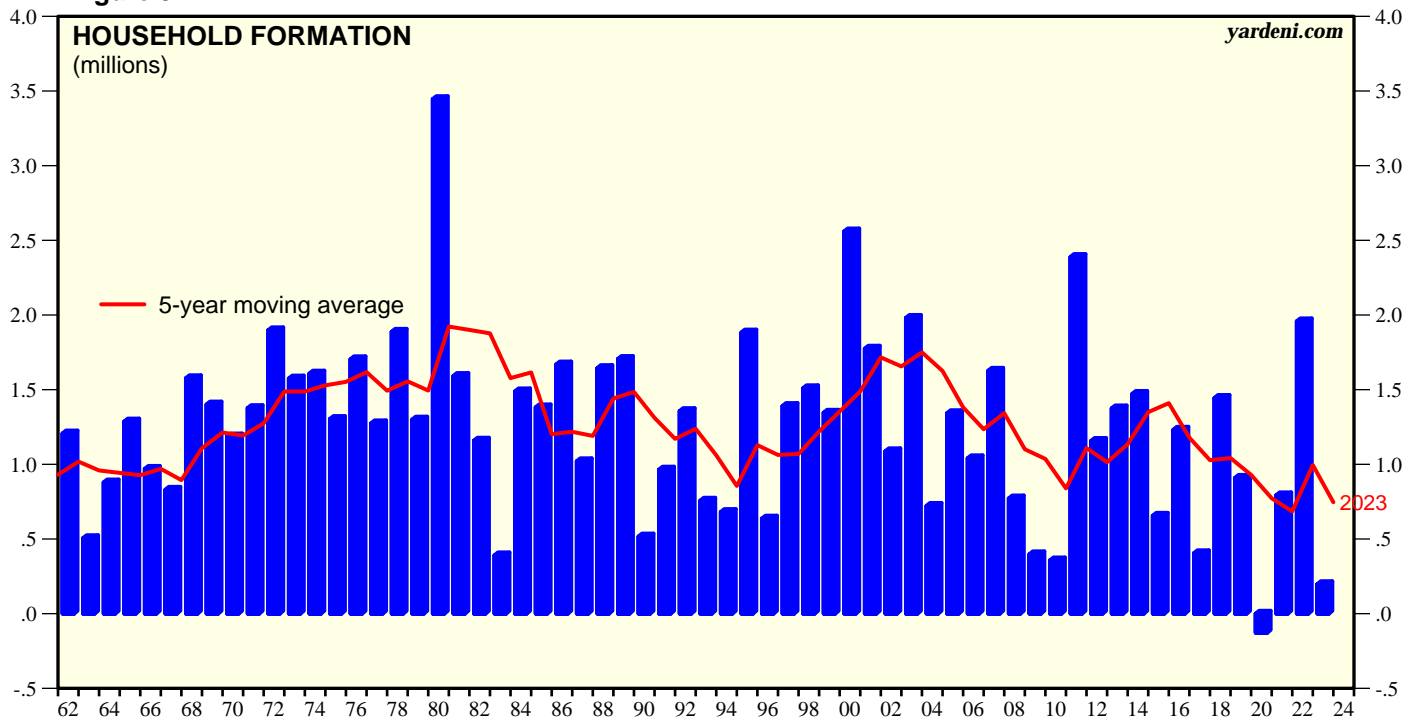

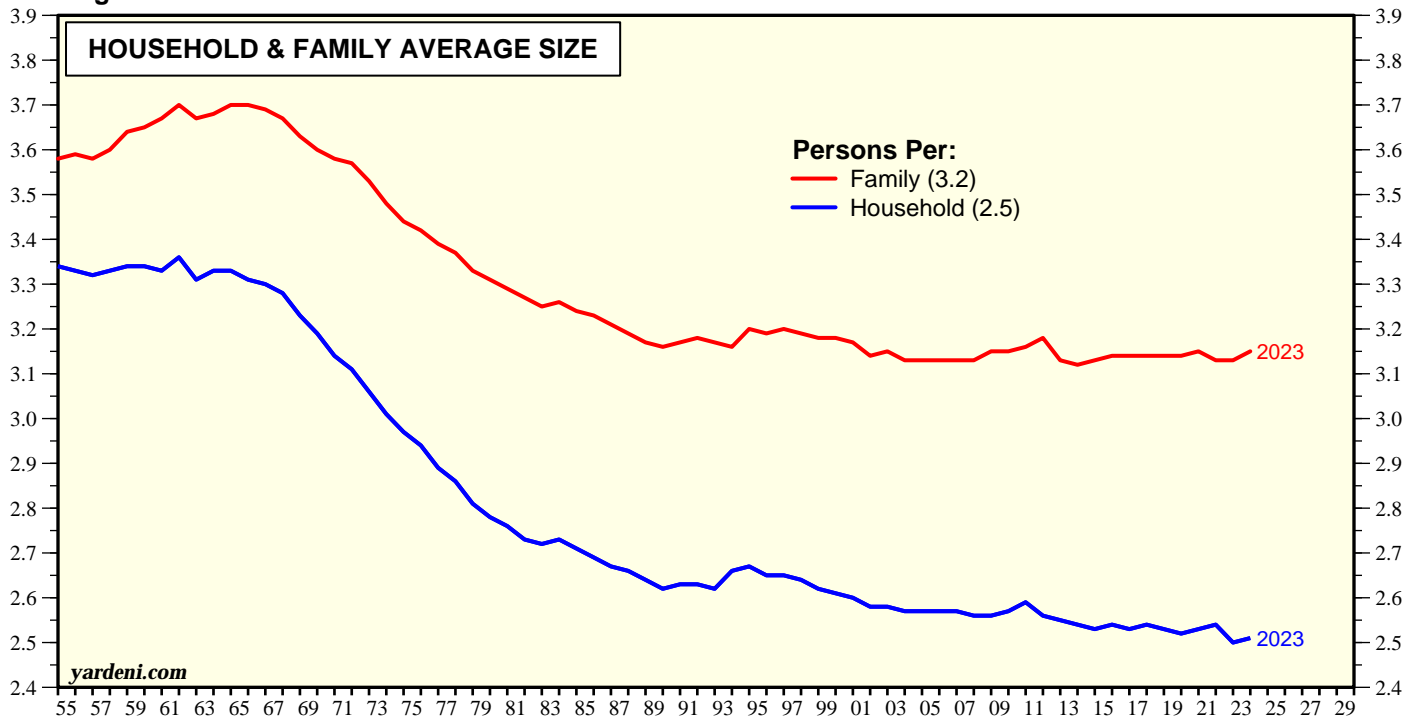

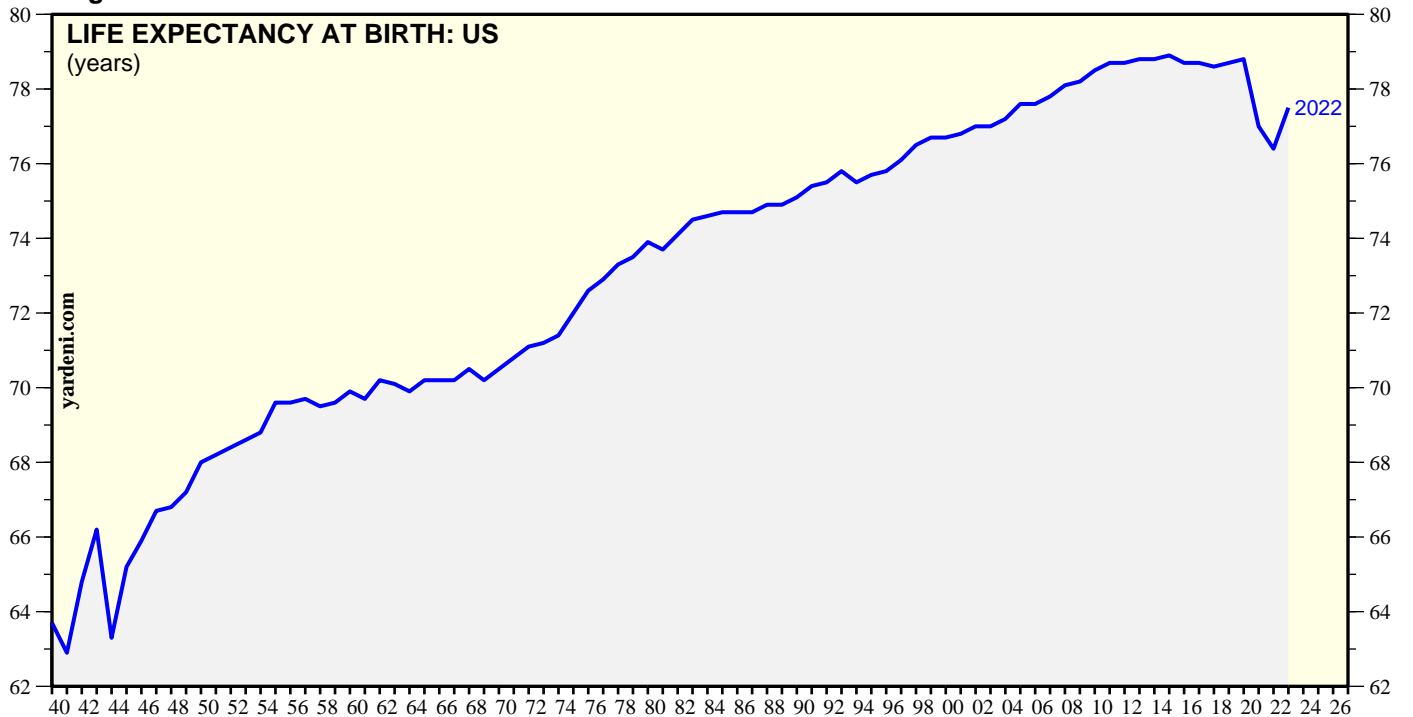
US Population: Characteristics

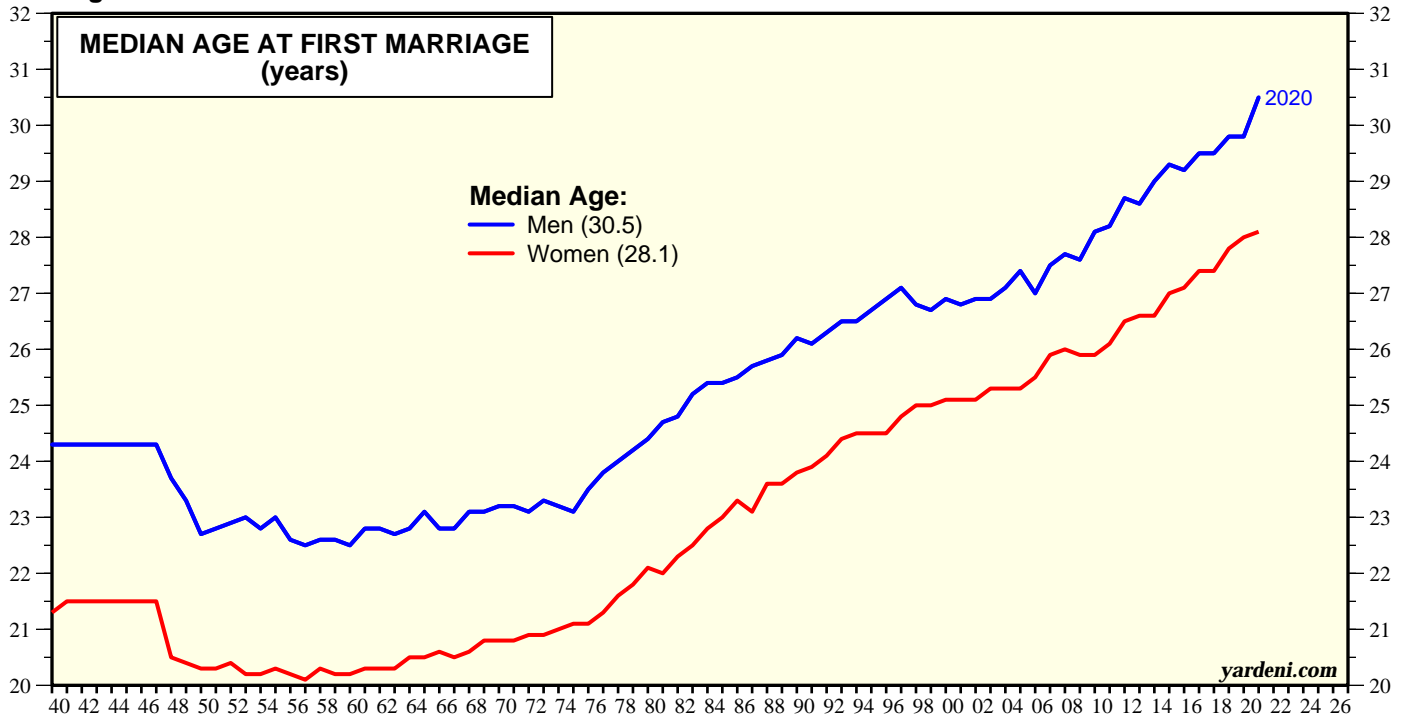

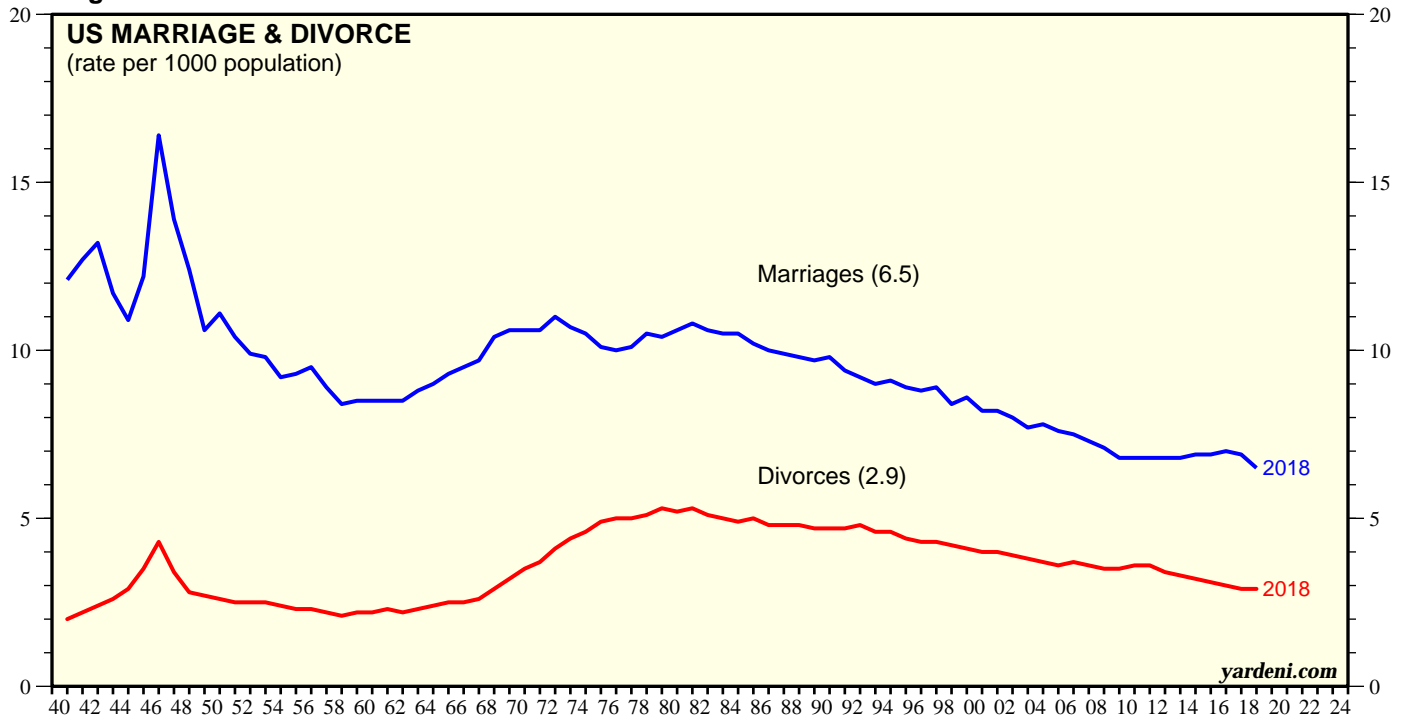

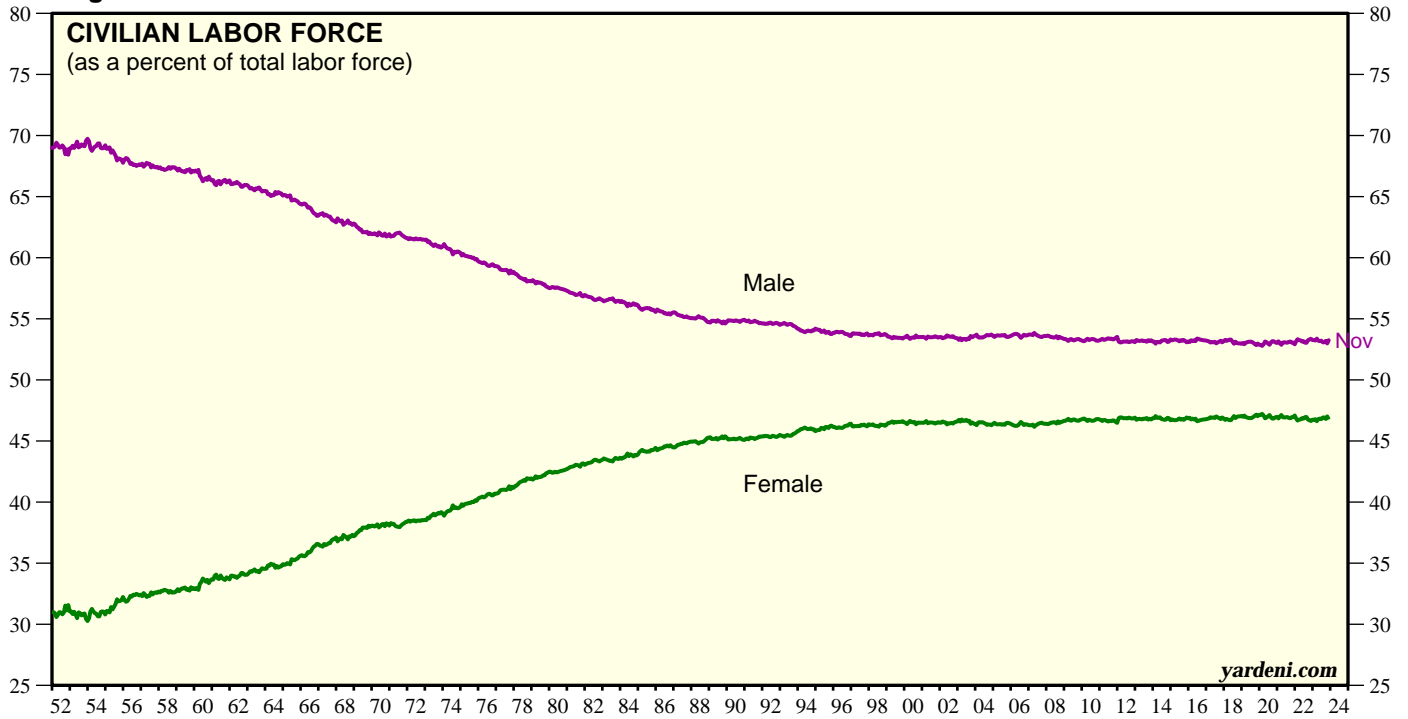

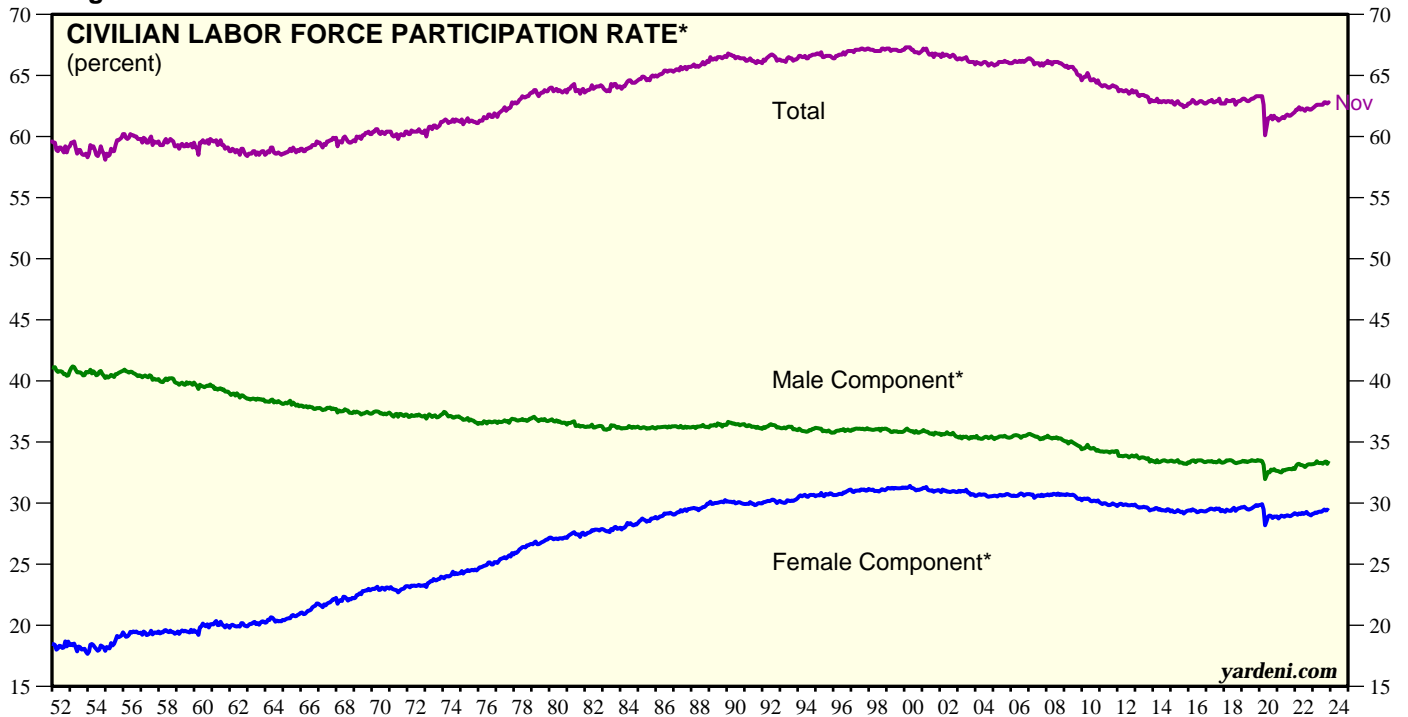
US Labor Force

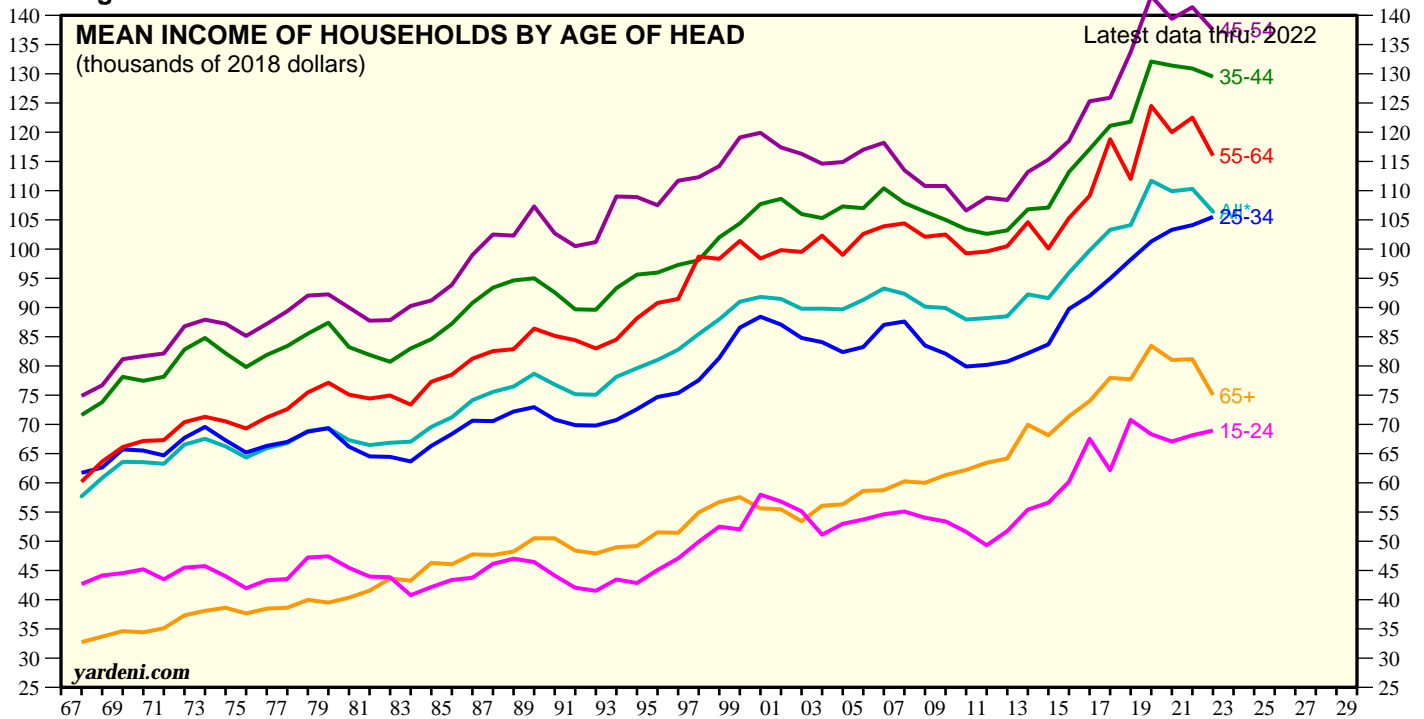

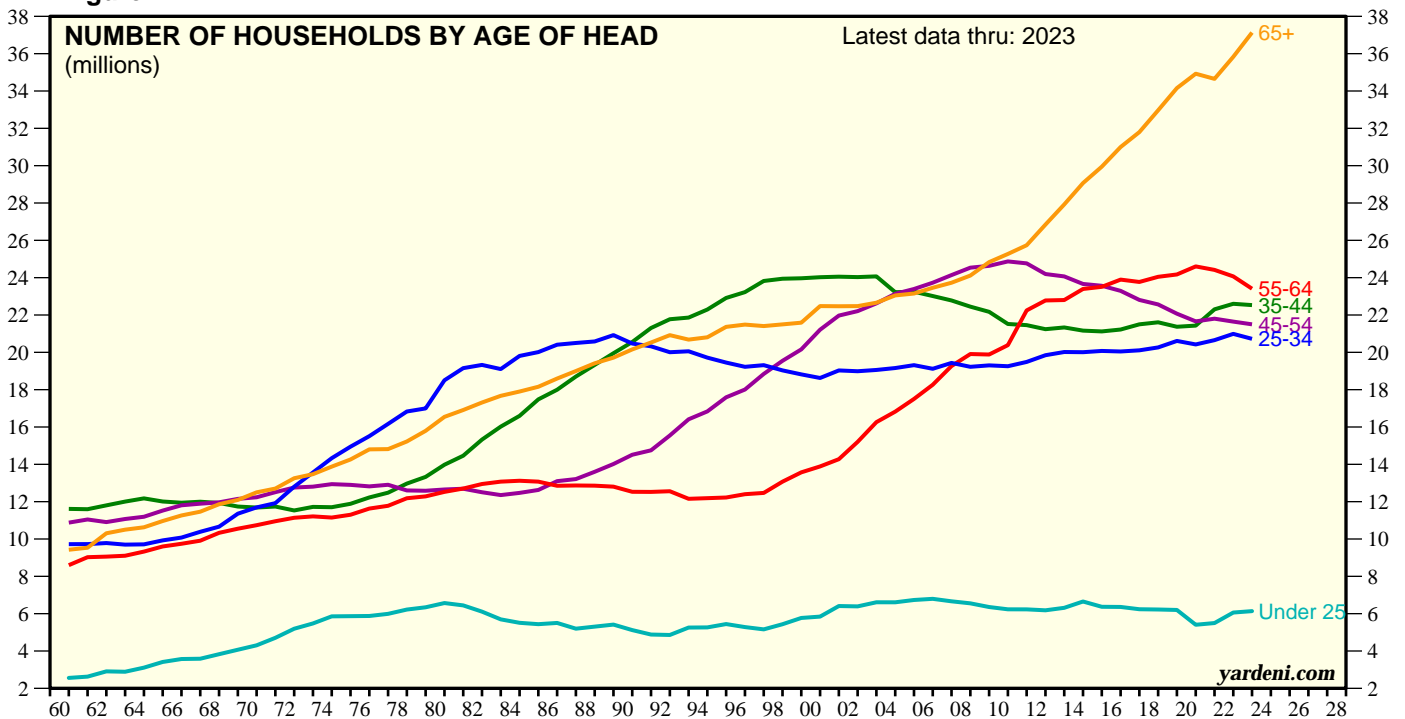
US Income Shares

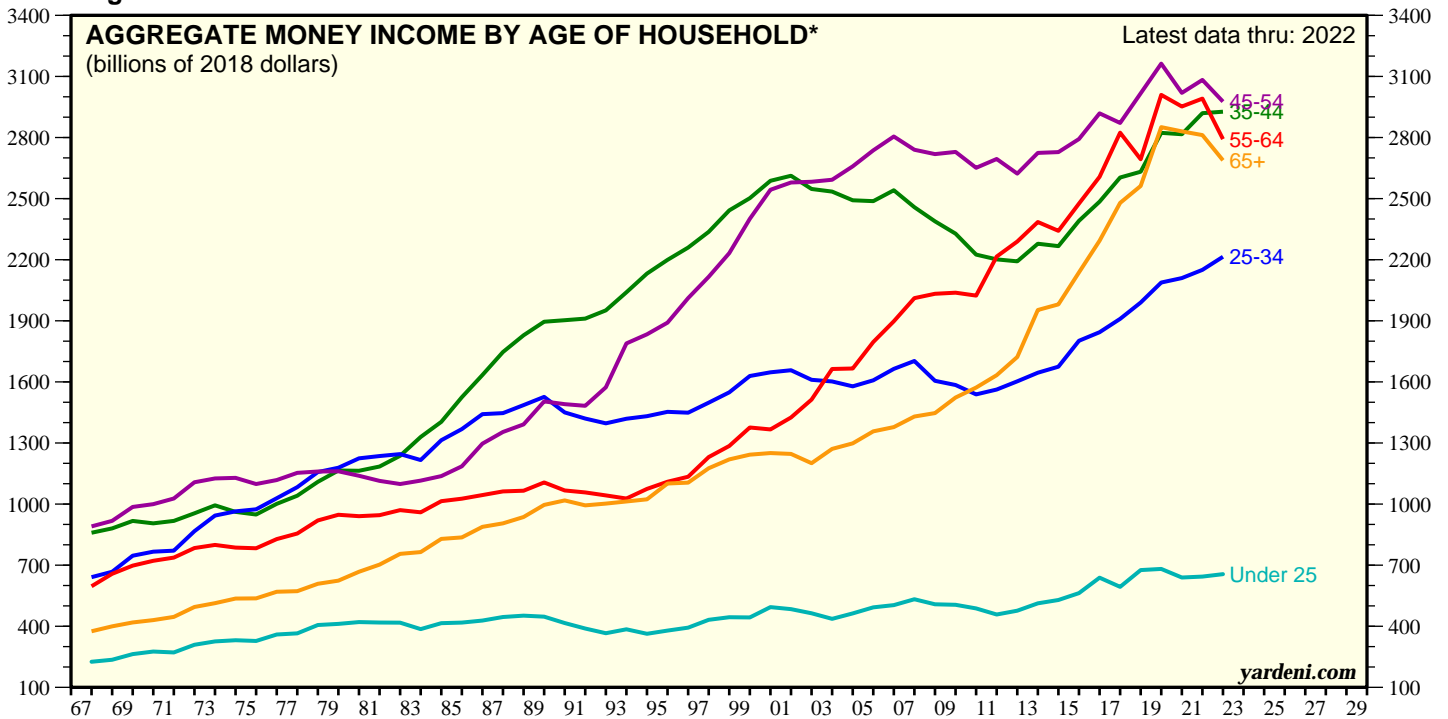

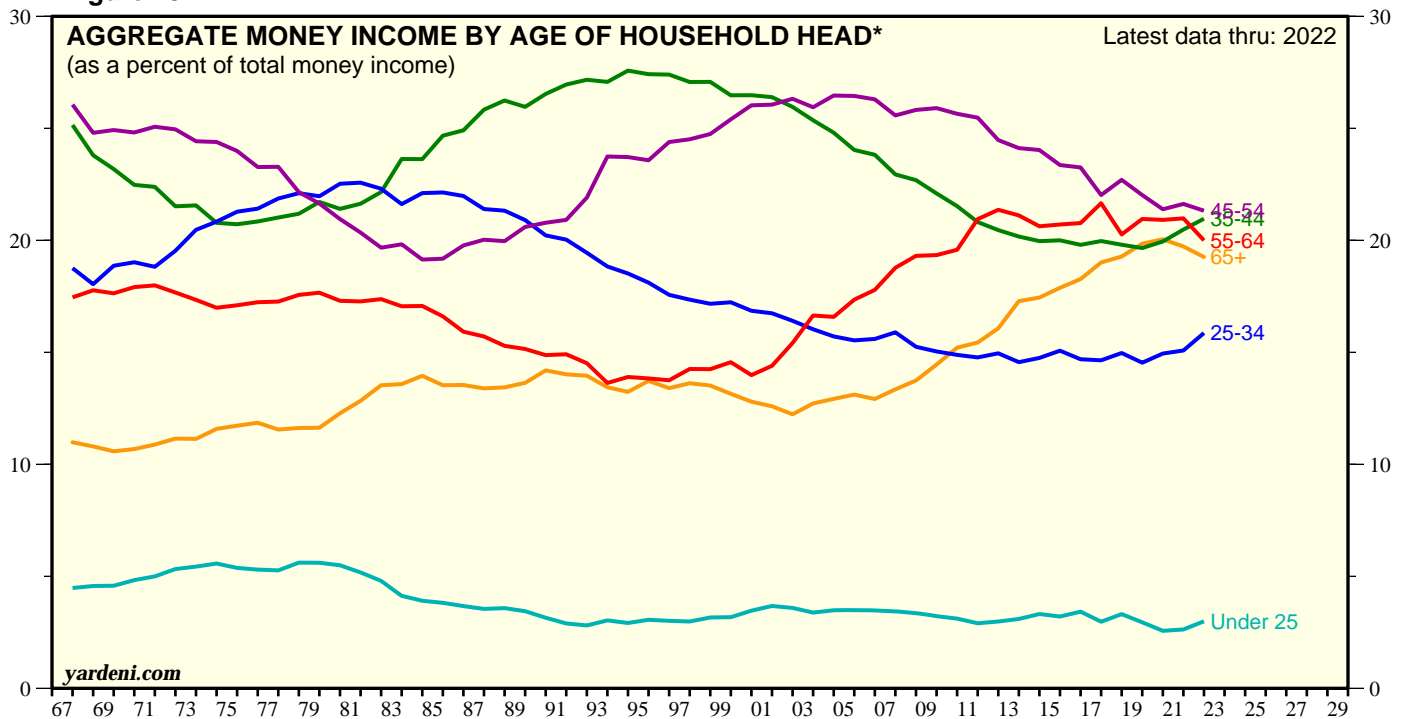
US Income Shares

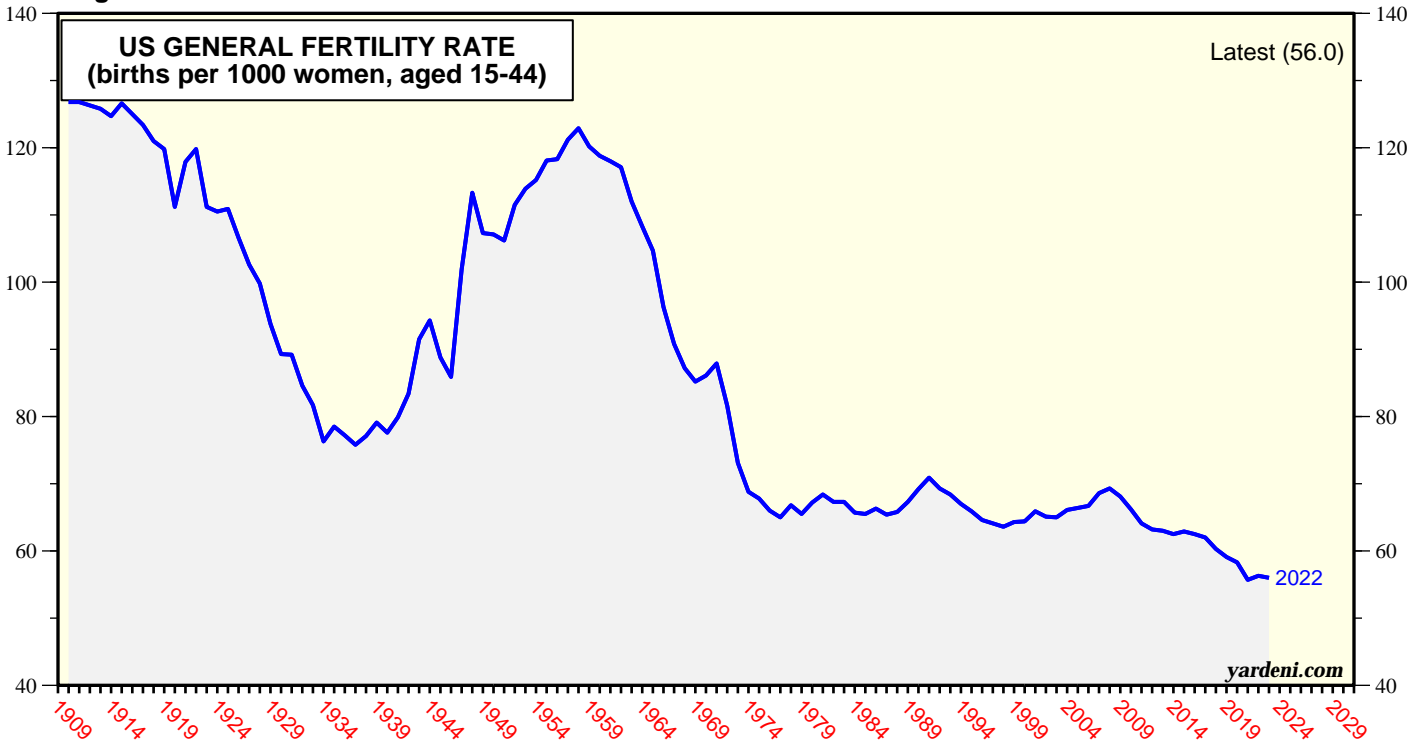

US Fertility Rate

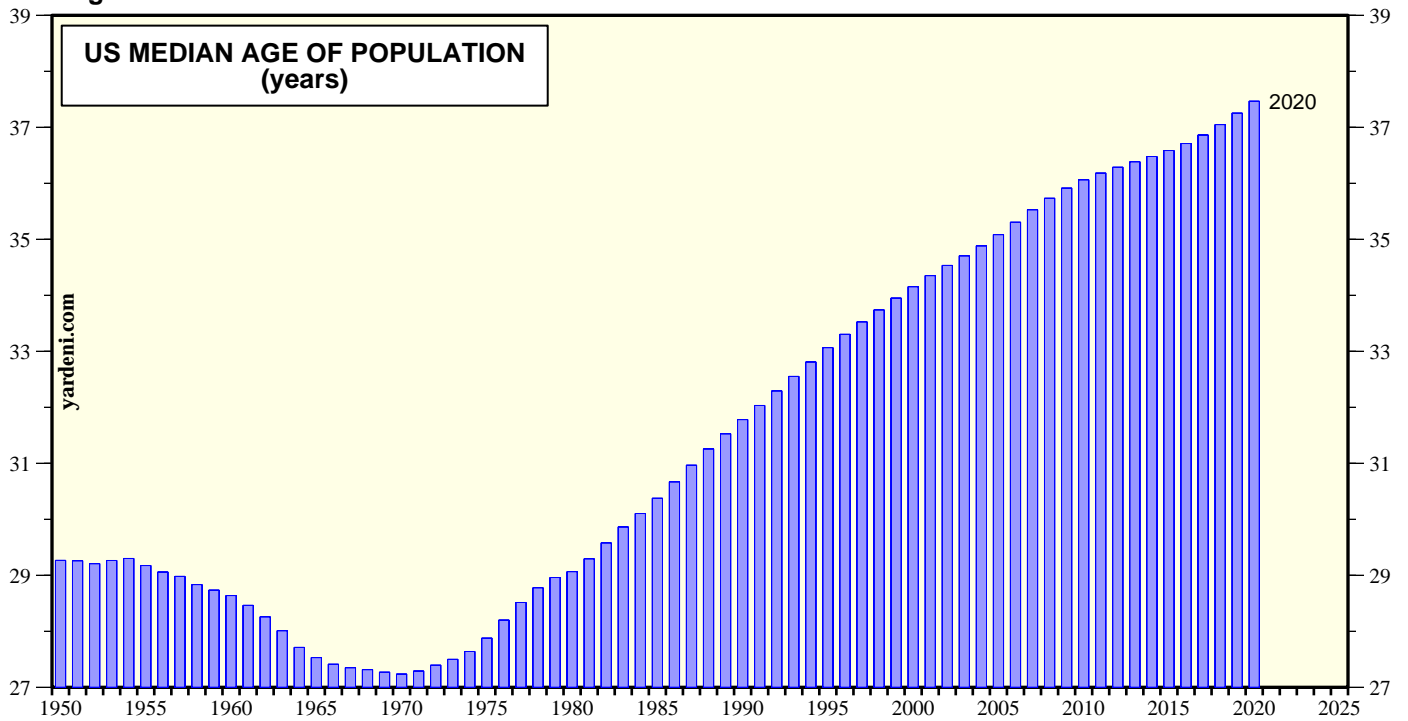
