
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US Federal Tax Receipts




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
Figure 20. 120 120 **GROSS FEDERAL RECEIPTS: CUSTOM DUTIES** (billion dollars, 12-month sum) 100 100 Nov 80 80 60 60 40 40 20 - 20 yardeni.com 0 0 192 193 194 195 196 197 198 199 00 10 102 103 104 105 106 107 108 109 101 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 122 23 24 25 26





US Treasury Social Benefits Deficit




